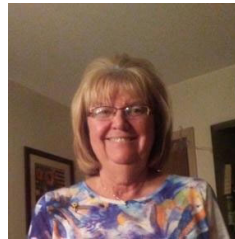

Been a Lion/Lioness for 34 years. Held various offices through the years and am presently the President of the Amity Township Club.

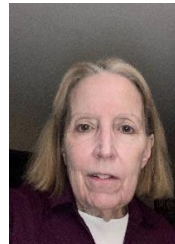

With help from his fellow Lion, William Ernst, the first Leo club was charted on December 5, 1957.

As the world's first Leo club, the Abington High School Leo Club created the Leo acronym – Leadership, Equality, Opportunity – and chose their school colors, maroon and gold to serve as the Leo club colors. Later, Equality was changed to Experience. In October 1967, the board of directors of Lions Clubs International adopted the Leo Club Program as an official program of the association.

The Leo Club Program has continued to grow within the last 50 years. Leos now constitutes an international network of over 6,500 clubs in over 140 countries. Community service remains the cornerstone of the program, fostering a lifetime commitment to helping others. Like their Lion counterparts, Leo club members enjoy serving their neighbors and watching positive results unfold.

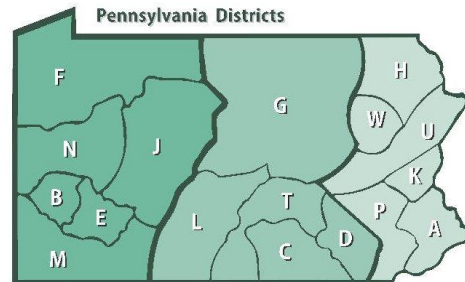

DRESS CODE

District 14-P has adopted the same Dress Code for its Cabinet Officers as the Pennsylvania State Council. - September 1 to April 30. Consists of PA Lions Green Shirt, Gray Trousers or Skirt and Dark Shoes

E: Formal Summer Dress:

- May 1 to August 31. Consists of White Dinner Jacket, Black Dress Pants or Skirt, Formal Shirt, Black Tie and Black Shoes

F: Formal Winter Dress:

- September 1 to April 30. Consists of Black Dinner Jacket, Black Dress Pants or Skirt, Formal Shirt, Black Tie and Black Shoes

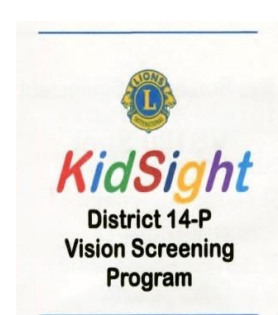

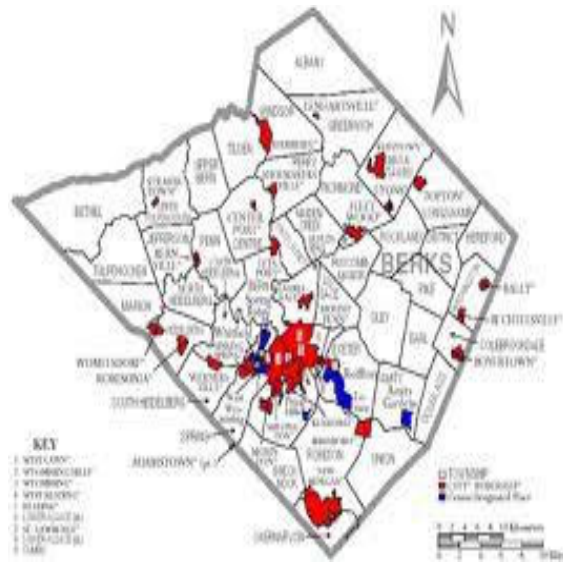
There are several ways in which Clubs and Individuals can support this worthy Foundation:
