44th Annual Halloween Parade.

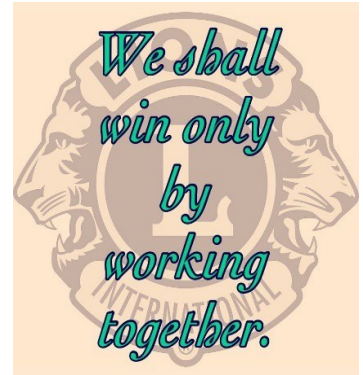

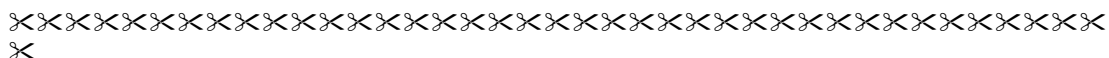
