



The Shillington Lions club provided funding to the Shillington Police Department for a firearm simulation training system. The Shillington Lions club funded \$13,300 for the system, with 50% of the funds provided by a grant through the Lions of Pennsylvania Foundation.

The DART Firearm Simulation Training System offers advanced simulation trainings including both stationary silhouettes and live decision-making scenarios. It also offers unique features such as programming layouts and de-escalation trainings.

Some other benefits of the system are the virtual design that means live ammunition is not required for training, and the portability of the system allowing for training to happen anywhere.
