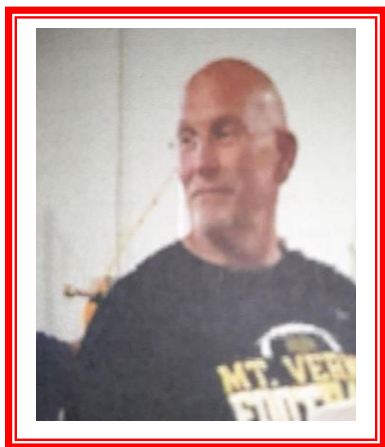
COACH MIKE KIRSCHNER
