Message from DG Patty Cooke:

Hello Lions of 25A:

Often I struggle with what to write in my monthly article. This month I turned to the LCI website for inspiration and found plenty in their Touchstone stories. Did you know that the Lions played a key in making the white cane the now universal and indispensable aid for the blind?

In Europe, there was a one-woman-campaign by a wealthy Parisienne named Mme. Guilly d'Herbemont. In America, Peoria Lions Club President George A. Bonham developed the effort after seeing a blind man struggling to cross a street. He thought of painting the tip white with a band of red and then brought the idea to his club. The Lions started painting canes and pursued a city ordinance – the first “white cane safety law”. The program was then presented at the next International Convention and by 1956 every state had enacted similar laws.

Lions Serve. We do make a difference in our communities, in our state and throughout the world. I know that there are many others who would like to join our team and help. Please ask your neighbor, cousin, or coworker to participate with your club in an activity – then to join your club. If they join right away, fantastic! If they don't, then ask again – and again.

A big “Thank You” to those who attended the recent District Meeting in Kouts. These events are a great way for the District leadership not only to share information with you, but to hear about all you are doing in your communities. And all the clubs of 25A are doing a great job!

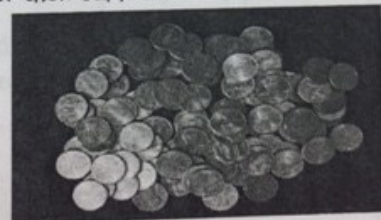

Region 2 meeting Jan. 16, 2017

Five clubs attended the meeting and decided to work the pancake & sausage sale at the Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore - Chellberg Farms again this year. This will be on the first and second weekends in March.

As to where the donation of profits go, one option was the Porter County Blind & Low Vision Program, housed at Morgan Township school. The other was a new one: Project Lifesaver. This is a tracking program to help find people with Alzheimer's, Dementia, Autism, Down Syndrome, or any other cognitive condition who have wandered from home. Right now Porter County Sheriff and the Crown Point Fire Dept. have the base units to track someone who is lost. Each person needs a small personal transmitter, which emits a tracking signal, worn around their wrist. If a person somehow gets lost from a home, the care giver calls one of these Departments and a team tracks the signal to find said person. The Cost of the Transmitters is about \$300.00 each. The batteries have to be changed once a month. Hobart Fire Dept. is raising money to buy the base unit. As of the last Zone meeting there were 35 people on the list to get transmitters when funds were available. Talk to your Clubs and let me know at the Zone meeting in Chesterton on Tuesday, February 14 which option your Club chooses to help this year.
