Dear Lioness,

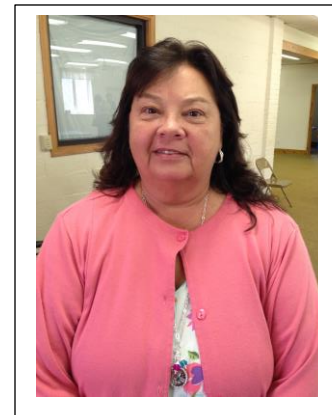

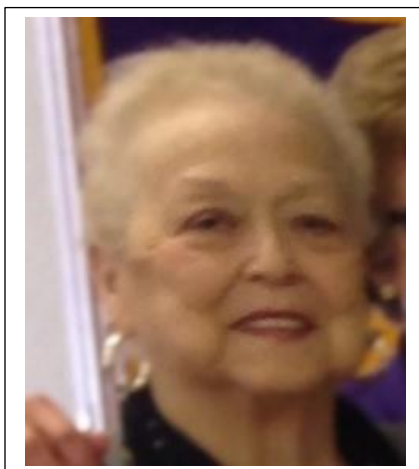
