President Spagnuolo introduced Ms Hannah Gotschok, Executive Director of SAFE CENTER, SafeCenter was formed in 1983, but became an official non profit organization in 1984, when Janet Holden realized the need for an agency to help victims of intimate partner domestic violence. With help of concerned citizens and many volunteers, SafeCenter was the first safe place for battered women and their children. SafeCenter now serves all gender identities who have experienced intimate partner domestic violence or sexual assault.

SafeCenter works with many community partners including law enforcement, social service agencies, schools and the healthcare community to prevent violence and promote justice and healing for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault.

### **Our Mission:**

Educate. Prevent. Advocate. Empower.

### **Our Vision:**

End domestic violence and sexual assault.

### **Emergency Shelter:**

SafeCenter provides temporary and safe housing for women and children. While in shelter survivors are provided with meals, personal care items, advocacy, and counseling. We do not currently house adult men, but we are happy to assist male survivors with finding a safe place.




