With the rise of COVID-19, elective surgeries were cancelled. Corneal transplants are considered an elective surgery; therefore, these past few months have been very hard months for Eversight. President/CEO of Eversight, Lion David Bosch, says, "The impact on Eversight has been severe. Providing corneal tissue for transplant provides for more than 94% of our operating revenue. We are now operating indefinitely at less than 5% of normal income.

We are doing everything we can to keep our people safe and employed, and remain financially viable so we can provide for surgeons and patients when this crisis ends. We have frozen hiring and spending, implemented reduced work weeks for all staff, and are fully pursuing grants, loans and federal support." Lion Dave's words were taken from an email appealing to all of the Lions Club of Michigan, to please donate any funds possible to Eversight. If your club hasn't yet donated, I really do encourage you to send whatever donation is feasible for your club. Please see the attached document of District 11-B1 Lions Clubs donations.

Tuesday, May 5, was designated as #GivingTuesdayNow, a new global day of giving and unity responding to the unprecedented need by COVID-19. Eversight participated in that event and reached out to its base with a goal of \$50,000. #GivingTuesdayNow was a part of Eversight's "Keep Hope in Sight" Spring Appeal Campaign.
