

**District 11-B1 – Global Service Report

For June 13, 2020 Cabinet Meeting**

The GST(Global Service Team) was comprised of 8 members. Our main goal was to promote Global Service projects as well as any service projects within all the clubs in the District The Global Service projects consisted of any projects in the following areas: Diabetes Vision/Hearing Hunger, Environment, and Childhood Cancer. We did promote the donation of yarn and making Cancer Caps for Childhood Cancer last Fall and had over 75% of our clubs participate in this area. We also promoted Hunger and the Needy with asking for donations of hygiene and food products to various shelters. Again we had 80% of our clubs help in this area. Many clubs also participated in KidSight, Leader Dog, Penrickton Center, Eversight , and Eye Glass Collection which covered the vision area. Overall we have had most all of our clubs in District 11-B1 support and promote service in their community! The biggest problem we have encountered is having clubs report their service to LCI ! It has been difficult with COVID-19 hitting us in March to do any kind of widespread service in the District but many of our clubs found ways to continue to meet the needs of those in their communities even with financial donations.
