LEO CLUB HISTORY

Coach Jim Graver started the LEO ball rolling in 1957 and chances are that ball was a baseball. Graver was the baseball coach of the Abington High School in Pennsylvania, USA and an active member of the Glenside Lions. With the help from his fellow Lion William Ernst, the first LEO club was chartered on December 5, 1957.

LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL PURPOSES:

TO ORGANIZE charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions Clubs.

TO COORDINATE the activities and standardize the administration of Lions Clubs.

TO CREATE and foster a spirit of understanding among peoples of the world.

TO PROMOTE the principles of a good government and good citizenship.

TO TAKE an active interest in civic, cultural, social and morale welfare for the community.

TO UNITE the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.

TO PROVIDE a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.

TO ENCOURAGE service minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.

LIONS CODE OF ETHICS

TO SHOW my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

Lions Information & Protocol

TO SEEK success and to demand fair remuneration or profits as my just do, but to accept no profit or success at the price of my self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.

TO REMEMBER that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and be true to myself.

WHENEVER a doubt arises as to the right of ethics of my position or actions towards others, to resolve such doubt against myself.

TO HOLD friendship to an end and not as a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it has grown.

ALWAYS bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor and means.

TO AID other by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak and my substance to the needy.

TO BE CAREFUL with my criticism and liberal with my praise: to build up and not destroy.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES:

ACTIVE MEMBER: All the rights and the privileges and subject to all obligations which membership in a Lions Club confers. Such rights include eligibility to seek and hold office and the right to vote. Obligations include the payment of dues and participate in Club activities.

AFFILIATE: A member who is not able to fully participate. This designation may be conferred by the Board of Directors. The member is not obligated to pay full dues and has voting privileges on club matters only: the Lion is not eligible to seek office or be a delegate at conventions.

Lions Club Meeting Help & Protocol

ASSOCIATE: Open to Lions who are an Active Lion of another club. The Lion pays dues at the Club level of the club to whom she/he is an associate and is eligible to vote on club matters when present.

HONORARY: An individual upon whom the club wishes to confer special distinction who is not a member of the club. Entrance fees and International dues must still be paid by the club. The member is not entitled to any privileges of active membership.

LIFE: May be conferred upon any member who has maintained active membership for 20 or more years; or for 15 or more years and reached the age of 70; or a member who is critically ill and has rendered outstanding service. Life-time membership may be granted upon recommendation of the Club and upon payment to LCI of \$650.00 in lieu of all future dues to the Association. The member has all the privileges of an Active Member. The club may choose to charge dues as it deems proper.

PRIVILEGED: The Board of Directors may confer this status on a member who has been active for at least 15 years and who because of illness, advanced age, or other legitimate reason, must relinquish Active status. The member will have all the privileges of membership except the right to seek office.

MEMBER AT LARGE: A member who has moved or for health or for other reason cannot regularly attend meetings. They can't seek office, must pay all dues and can vote on club matters when present. To be reviewed every 6 months.

2021-2022 DUES STRUCTURE:

LCI billing for a new member the first of the month in which the member enters the club at the average rate of \$3.58 per month and is billed thru the end of that semi-annual period.

Billing is issued semi-annually thereafter. New members are billed effective the first of the month they join and new member fee is not pro-rated*.

Lions Club Meeting Help & Protocol

LCI has waived the \$35 entrance fee for all new members joining before June 30, 2022.

Note: Multiple District dues of \$3.00 per year (\$1.50 per half year) and District S dues of \$7.50 (\$3.75 per half year), are not prorated and not included. Individual Club dues is not included.

HOW TO OPEN A LIONS MEETING

The Traditional "5" point opening:

1. One verse of America ('My Country Tis of Thee')
2. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag
3. Invocation
4. Lions' Toast (With water or holding hands) ("Not above you, not beneath you, but with you")
5. Thought for the day

INTRODUCTIONS

The president, being the presiding officer, should recognize those present in the following order:

1. District Governor
2. 1st Vice District Governor
3. 2nd Vice District Governor
4. International Officers
5. Past International Officers
6. Cabinet Secretary Treasurer
7. Region Chairpersons
8. Zone Chairpersons
9. Cabinet Chairpersons
10. Past District Governors
11. Lions Members
12. Guests

*Speaking order is in the reverse order of the introductions.

MEETING COURTESY HINTS

1. All Lions Clubs should provide flags, gong, gavel and other paraphernalia as necessary. The Lion Tamer should have these articles in their proper place prior to the beginning of the meeting.
2. The President should start the meeting on time and follow the procedures recommended by Lions Clubs International to open the meeting and to maintain decorum during the meeting. Programs should be interesting, informative and well attended.

Lions Club Meeting Help & Protocol

3. If a District Cabinet member is attending your meeting, your greeter should acknowledge their presence and properly introduce them to the members.
4. At the appropriate time, the President of the club should ask the Cabinet member to make a few remarks concerning Lionism.
5. If you invite the District Governor to a Club function, send a letter stating the type of function and explain the duties you would like the District Governor to perform, as well as the date, time and meeting place. The Cabinet Secretary–Treasurer should be included in the invitation.
6. If the spouse of the District Governor is invited, include the spouse of the Cabinet Secretary–Treasurer.
7. Please DO NOT engage a speaker or have a program on the date of the District Governor's official visitation. It is advisable to check with the Vice District Governors if they require the complete meeting or if a regular scheduled speaker or program should be planned. In any event, schedule some time for the Vice District Governor(s) and their message.
8. Always acknowledge visiting Lions and guests. A visiting Lion or guest can be overlooked and made to feel like an unwanted stranger at a Lions Club meeting.

THE BORROWING GAME

The game of borrowing club equipment is a long-standing tradition in Lions Clubs to encourage interclub visits and have a little fun. However, there are a few sometimes forgotten ground rules that go with this game.

The game begins when the meeting is called to order and ends when the meeting is officially adjourned.

Limit your taking to the gong, gavel or Tail Twister's bank. The Club Banner is off limits at all times. It is just too valuable and too easily damaged.

Lions Club Meeting Help & Protocol

Cabinet Members and Lions who are part of the evening's agenda are not allowed to partake in the "Borrowing" Game.

Special occasions such as Zone or Cabinet Advisory Meetings, or any public meetings and social functions, are off limits, including Mid Winter and State Conventions.

When item(s) are borrowed, the borrowing Club must notify the visited Club within 48 hours as to what item(s) were taken and when the Club meets again so the Club may retrieve the item(s) for a small donation to a Lion's charity.

Above all, act in good taste, have fun, and enjoy the merits of the "Borrowing Game".

INVOCATIONS

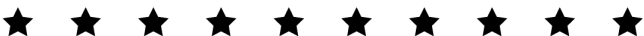

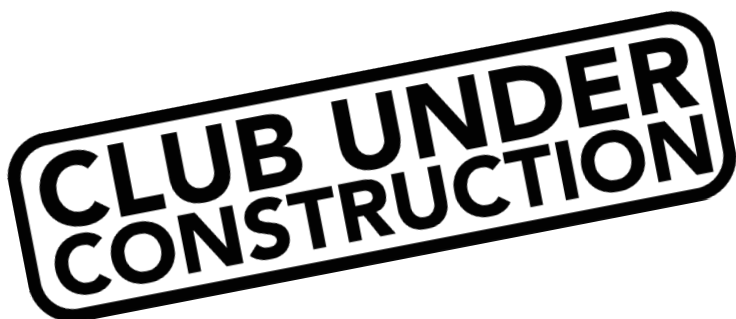
