

February 2020 Newsletter

The weather was not wintry. There was no competition from a Patrtiots playoff game. The guests arrived and departed on time. ID Gary and Lion Barb were extremely personable, contributed to our knowledge of Lions Club International events, initiatives, and recent Leadership changes. Four of our five Massachusetts Past International Directors attended some or all of the weekend.

We had comedians Sean Sullivan and Alice Henry on Friday night. The food was excellent. The Youth Speech competition included 4 very talented students, and left all of us with things to ponder, and a comfortable feeling of the talents and smart of our youth.
