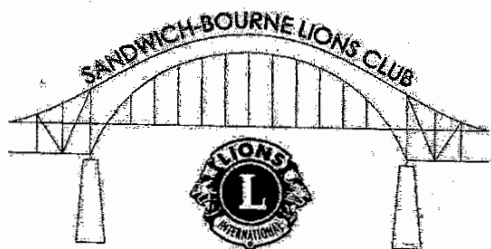

"A BRIEF HISTORY OF LIONISM"

Lions Club International began as the dream of Chicago businessman Melvin Jones in 1917. He believed that local Clubs should expand their horizons to the betterment of their communities and the world at large.

L.C.I. is the world's largest service Club organization with approximately 1.45 million Lions members in more than 46,000 Clubs, in 206 countries and geographical locations worldwide.

Lions' causes have included Sight Conservation, Hearing Services, Diabetes Awareness, Childhood Cancer, the Leo Club Program, Youth Exchange, and International Relations. Also, the Lions Clubs are involved in a variety of citizenship, educational, health, social, recreational, and community services.

In 1925, Helen Keller addressed the Lions Convention and challenged the Lions to become "*Knights of the Blind in the Crusade Against Darkness*". From that time on, Lions have been actively involved in service to the blind and visually impaired.

The motto of Lionism is "*We Serve*" and the official colors of the organization are purple and gold. Purple stands for loyalty and integrity, and Gold symbolizes sincerity of purpose, liberality in judgement, purity in life, and generosity to those in need.

The Lions emblem includes a gold letter "L" on a circular purple (or blue) field, and two Lion profiles on each side, each facing away from the center. This symbolizes our glorious past and a promising future.

LIONS MISSION

“To empower volunteers to serve their communities, meet humanitarian needs, encourage peace, and promote International understanding through Lions Clubs”

LIONS VISION

“To be the global leader in community and humanitarian service”

LIONS CAUSES

In addition to serving locally, Lions and Leos support five global service areas: vision, hunger, the environment, childhood cancer, and diabetes.

LIONS CLUB INTERNATIONAL PURPOSES

TO ORGANIZE, charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions Clubs.

TO COORDINATE the activities and standardize the administration of Lions Clubs.

TO CREATE and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.

TO PROMOTE the principles of good government and good citizenship.

TO TAKE an active interest in the civic, cultural, social, and moral welfare of the community.

TO UNITE the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship, and mutual understanding.

TO PROVIDE a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.

TO ENCOURAGE service minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works, and private endeavors.

LIONS CODE OF ETHICS

TO SHOW my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

TO SEEK success and to demand all fair remuneration or profit as my just due but to accept no profit or success at the price of my self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.

TO REMEMBER that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and be true to myself.

WHENEVER a doubt arises as to the right of ethics of my position or actions towards others, to resolve such doubt against myself.

TO HOLD friendship as an end and not as a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit of which it is given.

ALWAYS bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed. To give them freely of my time, labor, and means.

TO AID others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

TO BE CAREFUL with my criticism and liberal with my praise: to build up and not destroy.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

ACTIVE MEMBER: All the rights and privileges and subject to all obligations which membership in a Lion Club confers. Such rights include eligibility to seek and hold office and the right to vote. Obligations include the payment of dues and participate in club activities.

AFFILIATE: A member who is not able to fully participate. This designation may be conferred by the Board of Directors. The member is obligated to pay full dues and has voting privileges on club matters only, the Lion is not eligible to seek office or be a delegate at conventions.

ASSOCIATE: Open to Lions who are an Active Lion of another club. The Lion pays dues at the Club level of the club to whom s/he is an associate and is eligible to vote on club matters when present.

HONORARY: An individual upon whom the club wishes to confer special distinction who is not a member of the club. Entrance fees and International Dues must still be paid by the club. The member is not entitled to any of the privileges of active membership.

LIFE: May be conferred upon any member who has maintained active membership for 20 or more years; or for 15 or more years and has achieved the age of 70; or any member who is critically ill and has rendered outstanding service. Life membership may be granted upon recommendation of the Club and upon payment to LCI of \$650 in lieu of all future dues to the Association. The member has all the privileges of an Active Member. The club may choose to charge club dues as it deems proper.

MEMBER AT LARGE: A member who has moved from the community or for health or other legitimate reason cannot regularly attend club meetings may have this designation per the Board of Directors. The member owes all dues, but is not eligible to seek office and may only vote on club matters when present. The status must be reviewed every 6 months.

PRIVILEGED: The Board of Directors may confer this status on a member who has been active at least 15 years and who, because of illness, advanced age, or other legitimate reason, must relinquish Active status. The member will have all privileges of membership except the right to seek office.

LCI Billing for a new member begins the first of the month in which the member enters a club at the average rate of \$3.58 per month and billed through the end of that semi-annual period. Billing is issued semi-annually thereafter. New members are billed effective the first of the month they join and new member fee is not pro-rated. Below is a schedule of the new member dues throughout the year:

(Total dues shown includes the \$35 entrance fee billed only the first time a member joins. Active military and veterans are exempt from the entrance fee.)

LIONS MEETING COURTESY HINTS

1. All Lions Clubs should provide flags, gong, gavel and other paraphernalia as necessary. They Lion Tamer should have these articles in their proper place prior to the beginning of the meeting.
2. The President should start the meeting on time and follow the procedures recommended by Lions Clubs International to open the meeting and to maintain decorum during the meeting. Programs should be interesting, informative, and well attended.
3. If a District Cabinet member is attending your meeting, your greeter should acknowledge their presence and properly introduce them to the members.
4. At the appropriate time, the President of the Club should ask the Cabinet member to make a few remarks concerning Lionism.
5. If you invite the District Governor to a Club function, send a letter stating the type of function and explain the duties you would like the District Governor to perform, as well as the date, time and meeting place. The Cabinet Secretary-Treasure should be included in the invitation.
6. If the spouse of the District Governor is invited to attend, include the spouse of the Cabinet Secretary-Treasurer.
7. Please do not engage a speaker or have a program on the date of the District Governor's official visitation. It is advisable to check with the Vice District Governors if they require the complete meeting or if a regular scheduled speaker or program should be planned. In any event, schedule more time for the Vice District Governor(s) and their message.
8. Always acknowledge visiting Lions and guests. A visiting Lion or guest can be overlooked and made to feel like an unwanted stranger at a Lions Club meeting.

THE “BORROWING” GAME

The game of borrowing club equipment is a long-standing tradition in Lions Club to encourage interclub visits and have a little fun. However, there are a few sometimes forgotten ground rules that go with this game.

The game starts when the meeting is called to order and ends when the meeting is officially adjourned.

Limit your taking to the gong, gavel or tail twister’s bank. The Club Banner is off limits at all times. It is just too easily damaged.

Cabinet members and Lions who are part of the evening’s agenda are not allowed to partake in the “Borrowing” Game.

Special occasions such as Zone or Cabinet Advisory Meetins, or any public meetings and special functions, are off limits, including Mid Winter and State Conventions.

When item(s) are borrowed, the borrowing Club must notify the visited Club within 48 hours as to what item(s) were taken and when the Club meets again so the Club may retrieve the item(s) for a small donation to a Lion’s Charity.

Above all, act in good taste, have fun, and enjoy the merits of the “Borrowing” Game.
