2019 Community Food Packaging Event!

Building off November 2018's overwhelming success when 251 volunteers from all over Plymouth Count packaged 100,782 meals for those who hunger in Plymouth County, the Community Food Packaging Steering Committee has set a lofty goal of packaging 250,000 meals at the upcoming November 2019 event.

Last year's event, hosted at Joy in Christ Lutheran Church in Abington, was the first of its type in the community and it was the third largest food packaging event ever conducted in New England (there have been approximately 900 such events held in New England over the past 8 years).

This year's event will be held at the Abington High School gymnasium on Saturday, November 23rd with 600 volunteers participating in the event. Meals will be distributed to local area food pantries, school sponsored backpack programs and other outlets.

Each meal carries a cost of \$.25 and included in that cost is the transportation of USDA approved raw food materials from mid-west farmers, packaging materials as well as all the assembly line equipment needed to conduct the packaging.

We are soliciting local business, places of worship, civic aroups and members of the community at large to help us reach our funding goal of \$65,000.
\$62,500 covers the cost of the raw food materials while the balance will help cover the cost of renting needed equipment like pallet jacks for the day of the event. We are also seeking volunteers to work a two hour shift. A table of 10 people working in an assembly line type environment can produce 5000 meals in 2 hours!

As of this writing, the largest food packaging event to date in New England is 158,000 meas and the largest event in Massachusetts is 111,120 meals so this Abington based event will be the largest of its kind in New England!

All donations qualify for federal tax deduction under Section 501(c)(3) of the US Internal Revenue Code. An acknowledgement letter will be sent to all donors.

Thank you very much for your consideration and please communicate with me if you are interested in funding and/or volunteering. Funding needs to be completed by 10/1.
