To participate, you may walk, run, or bicycle along the Cape Cod Canal beginning at Scusset Beach. You may begin as soon as you are registered and go as far as you wish at your own pace.

If you are registered for the 5K or 10 K Race, the start and finish line will be adjacent to the Blink of an Eye assembly area. These will be timed and will start at 10:30.

Plenty of free food will be available beginning around noon. Games and activities will be set up for children, weather permitting.
