Only scrapbooks for current Lions year 2020-2021 may be submitted. Scrapbooks must be picked up from the exhibition area by 4:00 PM, on Saturday, April 24, 2021.
- 2. <u>Judging of scrapbooks</u>: The MD-24 General Chairperson of the Public Relations Committee will be responsible for arranging the judging of scrapbooks in accordance with the criteria listed above and will present a tally card to each club which shows exactly how many points were given for each item. First and Second Place will be presented awards by the MD-24 PR Chair PDG Woody Woodard during the Saturday April 24, 2021 General Session.
- **3.** <u>People's Choice:</u> Delegates will be able to view all scrapbooks. Ballots will be available to select the People's Choice.
