SUBJECT: REGISTRATION FORM B

Registration Form B is enclosed. The form MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO THE LIONS OF VIRGINIA STATE OFFICE BY March 30, 2022

Instructions for preparing Form B are as follows:

- 1. List each club delegate and alternate, including the office held, if any. Each club is allowed one (1) delegate for every 10 (or major fraction thereof) members on the membership rolls as of March 01, 2022. (Attach additional sheet(s) if necessary to include all delegates and alternates.)
- 2. Return the first (white) and the third (hard) copies to the Lions of Virginia State Secretary Lion Tammie Brightwell 501 Elm Ave. SW, Roanoke, VA 24016 in the envelope provided. Also, include a stamped, self-addressed envelope so that the Credentials can be returned to the club secretary.
- 3. After validation by the club president and secretary, the Credential cards are to be given to the delegates. Please do not lose them. **Delegates must have Credential cards to vote.**

Clubs may also submit a written list of Delegates via email to lionva@verizon.net.

NOTE: Article VII, Section I, of the Lions of Virginia Constitution states that a delegate must be registered and certified by the Credentials Committee on or before 5:00 pm on the day preceding the elections.

This means that delegates must be registered and certified by the Credentials Committee by 5:00 pm on Saturday, April 30, 2022 in order to vote on Sunday, May 1, 2022
