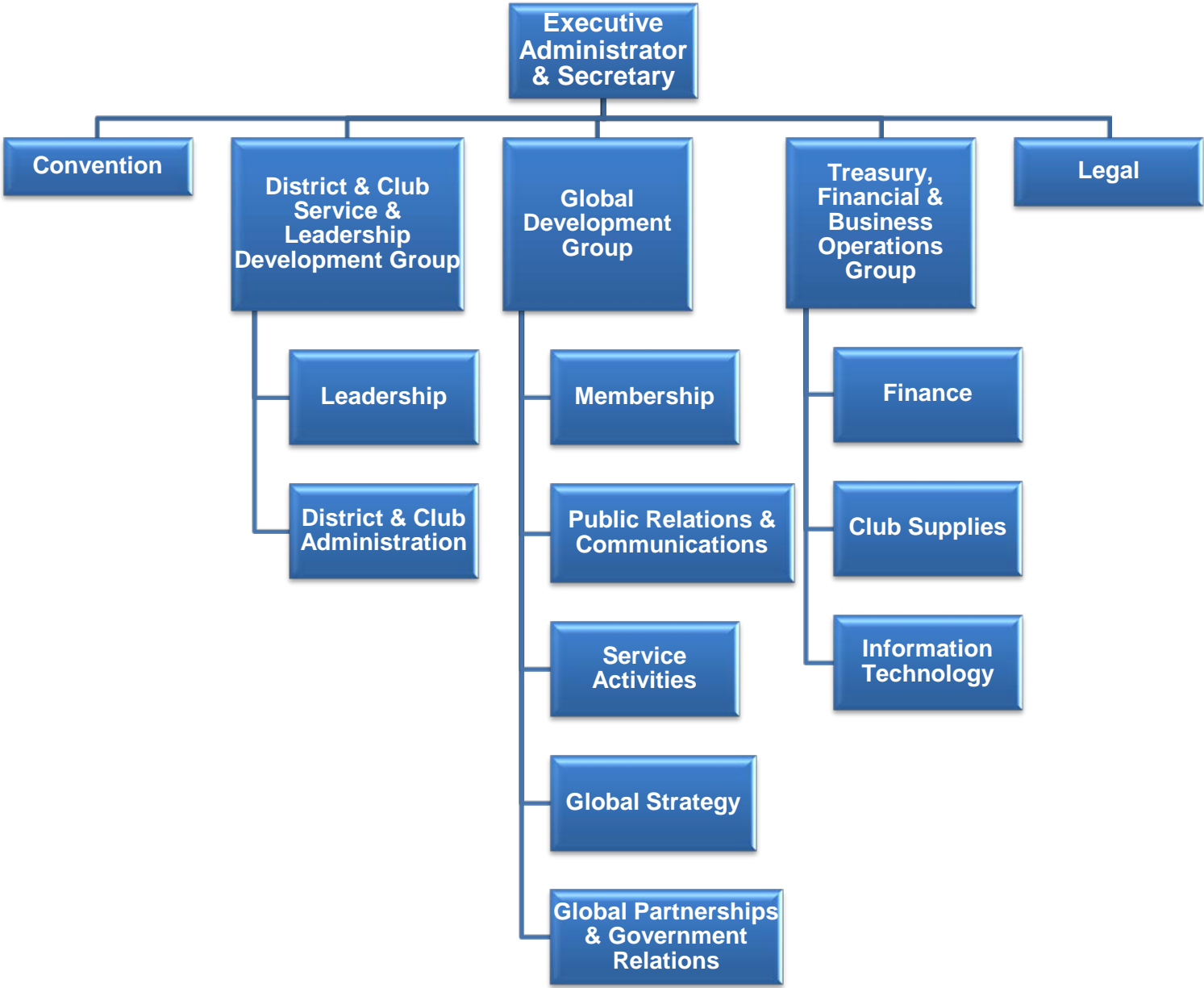

- Manage and administer the policies and programs of the International Board of Directors





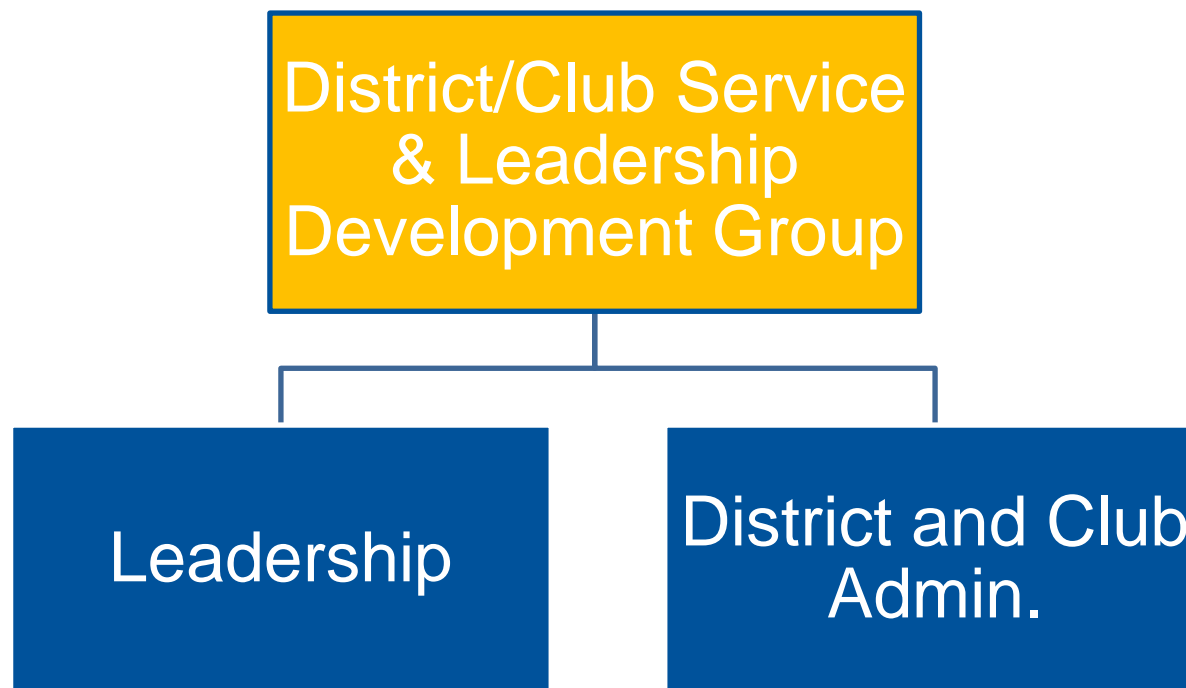
Gloria Geske

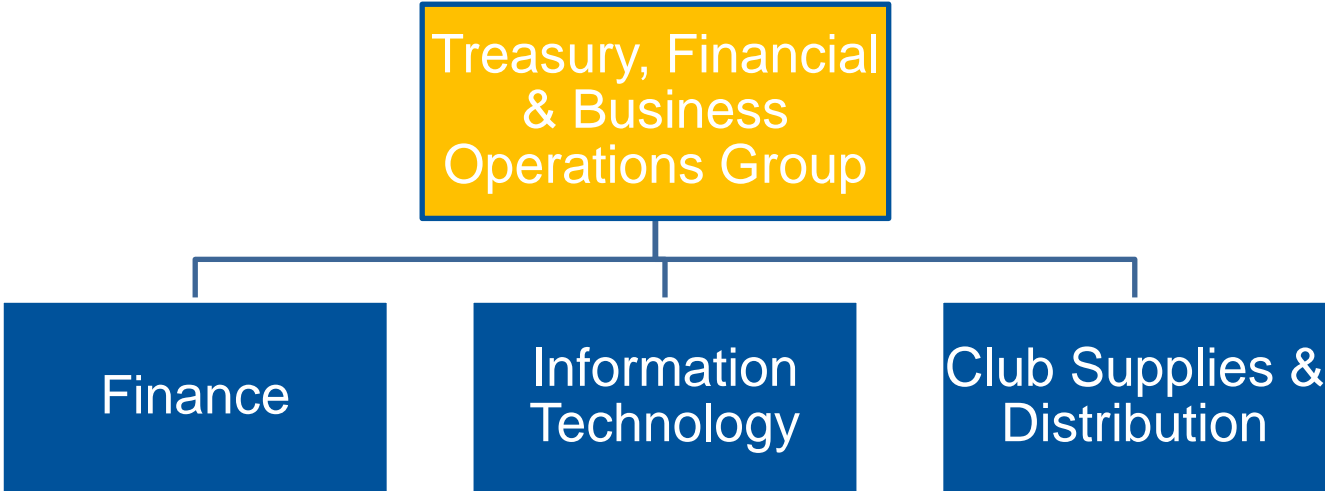
