WOW! WE HIT THE 35,000 MARK!

Thank you and congratulations to all of our KidSight volunteers for helping us screen more than 35,000 children so far this year. As of April 28, 35,590 children have been screened and 4,906 children have been referred for eye exams. That is a 13.8% rate of referral. In the 6C district 22,044 children have been and 3,061 referred for a 13.8 percent rate of referral. We still have two more months in the fiscal year – let's see how many more children we can screen!




