



### **Overview of Mission 1.5**

Mission 1.5, Lions International's global membership growth initiative, set an ambitious target: to grow Lions Clubs International to **1.5 million members worldwide**. The campaign focused on:

- Recruiting new members with passion and purpose.
- Strengthening club retention and engagement.
- Work to assist where needed to help clubs meet community needs or causes for service.

As GMT Coordinator, I will work closely with our district's leadership, Global Action Team, and clubs to align our efforts with Mission 1.5. While we've made significant gains in awareness and training, our year-end membership data reveals key challenges—particularly around retention and club vitality.

### **Conclusion**

This Lions year brought both learning and challenge. While 284 membership drops signal the need for more strategic action, they also provide valuable insight into how we can better serve our members, engage our communities, and build lasting clubs.

Let us move forward with clarity, compassion, and commitment to the Lions' mission—and to reaching 1.5 million strong.

Governor Richard wants as many clubs as possible to be honored with the Club Excellence award for the 2025-2026 lions' year. The requirements needed to receive this award will be released by the International President AP Singh in the very near future.
