Lions Quest – What is S.E.L.?



Social emotional learning (SEL) is a methodology that helps students of all ages to better comprehend their emotions, to feel those emotions fully, and demonstrate empathy for others.

These learned behaviors are then used to help students make positive, responsible decisions; create frameworks to achieve their goals, and build positive relationships with others.

SEL is helpful to both children and adults, increasing self-awareness, academic achievement, and positive behaviors both in and out of the classroom.

Since its founding over 30 years ago, Lions Quest has consistently tackled the issue of the day: Alcohol and Drugs (Give Hugs Not Drugs); Anger Management; Bullying; and Conflict Management. Lions Quest: a school based, educator led system of modules designed to fit the curriculum from Pre-K to Grade 8.
