Council of Governors Meeting

October 8, 2021

Meeting Summary

The second MD-7 Council Meeting for fiscal year 2021-2022 was held on October 8, 2021, via virtual meeting. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Council Chair Jeremey Kimble. The invocation was given by DG Rene Roberts and pledge led by DG Roy Patterson.

CC Jeremy Kimble welcomed everyone to the meeting.

The minutes from the Council Meeting, July 10, 2021, were reviewed and approved. A motion was made by DG Rene Roberts seconded by DG Roy Patterson to approve the minutes as presented. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

DG Don Young, Council Treasurer, provided a Financial Statement as of August 31, 2021. A motion made by DG Carol Allen and seconded by DG Rene Roberts to accept the report as presented. Motion approved. A copy will be filed for audit.

Old Business: PCC Bill Heaston received a bid to purchase 4,000 brochures for the Retinal Screening. This will close the UAMS/Lion's grant.

New Business:

A brief discussion was held regarding the Special Events Planning Committee. It was decided that this committee would not be needed, the events for 2022 have already been planned. A motion was made by Rene Roberts and seconded by DG Roy Patterson to disband this committee. Motion approved.

A brief discussion was held regarding the 2022 Mid-Winter Leadership Forum. PDG Phyliss Fry, Chair and Conway Noon Lions Clubs will host the 2022 Mid-Winter

Leadership Forum. Save the date - Saturday, **January 8, 2022**, "*Service from the Heart*." The event will be held at Central Baptist College, 1501 College Ave, Conway, Arkansas. A discussion was held regarding having an auction and a 50/50 pot.

Exciting New presenters and great breakout sessions. Membership (PCC Tracy Price) Service Activities (PDG Jeff Davis) Guiding Lion (PCC Myrna McGee) Vice District Governors (PDG Leanna Rich) Club Officers- President (PCC Bill Heaston) Secretary (Lion Rita Price) Treasurer (DG Rene Roberts) Lions of Arkansas Foundation (President Carla Mosley) and LCIF (PDG Mike Benefield).

A discussion was held on the 104th Annual Lions State Convention. PDG Pat Snodgrass, presented an update regarding the 2022 Arkansas Lions State Convention. This year theme is *"IT' S GREAT TO BE A LION"*. This event will be held May 13 & 14, 2022, at the Embassy Suites-Jonesboro. Your time will be well spent-informative and fun!

PDG Wanda reminded us that a motion was made stating the auction fund would be deposited in the State general funds and the 50/50 be donated to the Past District Governor's Association. (Minutes July 7,2021)

A motion was made by DG Rene Roberts and seconded by DG Roy Patterson to add two members to the Information Technology committee. PCC Myrna McGee to help with zoom meeting and PDG Wanda Green to assist on updates on the Arkansas Lions web site.

Lion Bec Dwyer-Coop presented the need of a group home to be housed at World Service for the Blind. WSB will undertake the remodeling of the Pinkerton and Fowler buildings in order to convert into single use accessible rooms, with common areas, classrooms and staff offices. A motion was made by DG Don Young and seconded by DG Roy Patterson to support the grant application to Lions Clubs International Foundation for a group home project, at World Service for the Blind. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

All the reports were reviews and each chair is available to assist the districts' leadership when asked. A motion was made by DG Roy Patterson and seconded by DG Rene Roberts to accept the written reports as presented. Motion passed.

PDG Phyllis Fry reported that a memorial was sent to the Fayetteville Lions Club for PDG Jane Treat. She also asked if the DGs know of the passing of Past District Governor to please inform the PDG's Association

Lion Bonda Moyer reported that this is the 60th Anniversary of Youth Exchange and Lions Club International has a video of past events is available to view on line.

PCC Myrna McGee reminded the District Governors of the election to be held for a Lions of Arkansas Trustee. Please send the representative information to Lion Carla Mosley.

A discussion was held on our State Pins. PDG Carolyn Marlin has resigned from Lions Clubs International Pin Trader Association. We were informed that only 2 pin trader vendors were at the 2021 USA/Canada Forum. Several of the Pin Trader representative have recently left the group due to death, age or decline of interest. Lion Wanda reported that a representative from Missouri said that he thought in a few years this organization will cease to exist. A recommendation to address this issue at the next council meeting.

Toni Shockey, VDG reported she attended a seminar at USA/Canada Forum on Childhood Cancer. She suggestion that we could sell T-shirts for a fund raising for this. It was recommended to address this issue at the next council meeting.

Newsletter / Public Relations: Jeff Davis, PDG



We had a "meet and greet" (via zoom) with both the first and second vice district governors on Sept. 14 @ 8PM. We will host our 1st Vice District Governors on the 2nd Thursday of the next three months and we will host training on the 3rd Thursday of the next three months with the 2nd Vice District Governors. The curriculum has remained unchanged since last year, so we will follow a similar schedule as we did last year.
