



If you don't see your club's posts being shared it could be because your privacy setting are blocking them from being posted. (Such as having a private group page rather than a fan page, or a photo is marked to be shared with "Friends Only".)

Individual club's Facebook pages are listed with their club information in this directory. Links to individual Lions club facebook pages and websites can also be found on the e-district site on the Find a Local Lions Club tab.

Lions 16 L Express (District wide email)

Any Lion in the district with an email address entered into

MyLCI (membership data base maintained by each club's secretary) should automatically receive the 16 L Express messages unless they unsubscribe.



Items such as the district's

newsletter, (*Governor's Gazette*), the State e-newsletter (*NJ LION*), as well as club and project event announcements, and information about training, district and zone meetings, and other news of interest to Lions, are sent out periodically on the 16 L Express.

Time sensitive information, such as a funeral announcement or an event cancellation due to a snow storm, will be sent out as soon as possible. But otherwise, 16 L Express e-mailings will be limited to a few times a month so as to not clog up your inbox. It may be a week before something you send in gets sent in the 16 L Express e-letter so plan ahead.

If you have not been receiving the 16 L Express and want to subscribe, or view past messages sent on the express, please visit: http://www.lionsdistrict16l.org/express.php. As is the case with many mass emails, the 16 L Express messages may wind up in your spam folder, so double check there if you are not receiving them. You can also use the above link to edit your preferences for the format you receive it in. (opt out of .html version and you won't get pictures in the message).

Press Releases

To raise their profile, Lions Clubs should regularly write and send press releases directly to local media outlets about their events and service projects. Sample press releases on topics ranging from promoting your Centennial Legacy Project to announcing you newly elected club officers can be found on www.lionsclub.org. Type "sample press release" in the search box by clicking on the



magnifying glass icon at the upper right corner of the website, for word document templates and additional tips about reaching the media.

Clubs should create a list of media contacts for their region so it is handy and ready to use whenever the need arises. Please note that sending a press release to the *NJ Lion*, 16 L Express or the Governor's Gazette does not mean those publication editors are going to send your message out to the media for you, but may include information contained in the press release as part of their publication.

DISTRICT 16 L SOCIAL MEDIA IMPACT AWARD

Awarded to the district club that has made the best use of Social Media as a public relations tool to share how they make an impact on the lives of those they serve.

Clubs should send the District Governor the appropriate information needed to locate examples of their social media presence (such as a Facebook URL, Instagram name, twitter handle, etc.) by March 1, 2018. Posts made between July 1,



2017 and April 30, 2018 are eligible for the contest.

A committee appointed by the District Governor will review and judge the submissions. Points will be given for quality of content, frequency of messages, shareability, and reach. Content should be action or results oriented. For example, a photo of a Little League team playing in their new Lions sponsored uniforms, or Lions stocking a food pantry shelf, would earn more points than a photo of an oversized check presentation. Donations are very important but for this contest we want to "see the impact" the donation makes.

J. HANLEY WILKERS ZONE PUBLIC RELATIONS CONTEST



Presented to the club in each Zone for development and implementation of a public relations program which embraces all facets of community activity and media relations. Internal as well as external public relations postures will be weighed in the

competition. Each club should **submit a portfolio** of their public relations efforts undertaken between May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018 to the District Governor for judging. The deadline to submit the portfolio is April 30, 2018.

All materials should be assembled into the portfolio and mailed or delivered at the same time. A portfolio can include items such as:

- Samples of the club newsletter or e-newsletters
- Photographs of visible promotions such as an installed Centennial Legacy Projects, Lions Highway signs, street banners, Little League ballfield sponsor signs, highway billboards;, etc.
- URLs or QR codes of club websites or Facebook pages;
- Newspaper or magazine clippings;
- Videos (provide a hyperlink or put on a DVD)
- Short essay describing an activity that promoted the club such as a booth at a community day or hosting a holiday parade.

Clubs are welcome to share newsletters, links to TV spots or clippings from newspapers with the District Governor as they occur, but only items sent in the final portfolio will be considered for judging. Clubs should save an extra copy of a clipping or newsletter, etc. for the contest submission.

HAROLD P. NUTTER CLUB FELLOWSHIP AWARD

(16 L Club award for visitations)

For a Club to qualify for this award, members must, on visiting a neighboring Club at it's regular meeting, have the secretary of the host Club sign a visitors slip. This slip should then be turned in to the secretary of the home club. The secretary of the home club will in turn send it to the District Governor. (Scanned and emailed slips will be accepted.)



This contest is applies to visitations made by all members of all clubs in District 16 L other than:

- International Directors, International Counselors or Past Governors on official visits.
- 2. Zone Chairman on official visits.
- 3. Members seeking office and their campaign associates.
- 4. Members of a club who have canceled their own regular scheduled meeting for the purpose of visitation.

The object of this award is to improve Lionism and Lion's Fellowship through visitations in addition to regular scheduled meetings of a members own club.

This contest will run from July 1, 2017 to April 30, 2018 after which time the Lions Club showing the most members making visits to neighboring clubs, by virtue of slips in the Governor's hands (or email inbox), will be awarded the "Harold P. Nutter Fellowship Award" at the State Convention.

Harold P. Nutter from the Camden Lions Club, was the International President in 1951-1952.

This District 16 L Program is a "hands on" Lions project to detect lazy eye and uncorrected refractive errors in children ages one through six. The testing procedure utilizes a portable hand held screening device. After a short training on how to use the device, Lions can quickly and easily detect vision issues for children as young as 6 months of age. The device screens both eyes at once from a nonthreatening 3-foot distance. The touch-screen display allows for one-touch activation, and simple management of patient data entry. The information acquired is used to automatically assess a child's vision in as little as five seconds. The result is then transferred to the South Jersey Eye Center for further review.

The program is a part of South Jersey Eye Center and Lions Clubs International Foundation's SightFirst Project which is an initiative to build and improve eye care systems to fight blindness and vision loss and assist blind and visually impaired persons in underserved communities. Along with LCIF, this program is funded and supported by the clubs of District 16 L, South Jersey Eye Center and other philanthropic agencies and organizations.

L.E.E.D.S. is the conduit through which local clubs can borrow Spot Cameras to screen pre-verbal through Kindergarten children for numerous eye conditions, including amblyopia, which may become permanent if not detected prior to 7 years of age. L.E.E.D.S also provides diabetes education and assistance through the CentraState Medical Center Wellness Program.



GLOBAL ACTION TEAM MAKE-UP

The Council Chairperson is the leader of the Multiple District's Global Action Team (GAT), which consists of the Multiple District's Global Leadership Team Coordinator (GLT-MD), Global Membership Team Coordinator (GMT-MD) and Global Service Team Coordinator (GST-MD). The MD Coordinators are selected by the multiple district (per the multiple district constitutional bylaws) as a non-voting member of the council of governors for a three-year term.

Similarly, the **District Governor** is the leader of the District's **Global Action Team (GAT)**, which consists of the District's Global Leadership Team Coordinator **(GLT-D)**, Global Membership Team Coordinator **(GMT-D)** and Global Service Team Coordinator **(GST-D)**. The District Coordinators are selected for <u>one</u> year terms by the district (per the district constitutional by-laws) as a member of the district cabinet.
