

I wish I had attended sooner! The keynote speakers were very inspirational. I especially enjoyed and was inspired by Jen Bricker, the gymnast without legs who became a State Champion in power tumbling, and Willie Jolley, a notable motivational speaker and singer. Besides meeting Lions from across the USA and Canada, I was able to attend 10 informative seminars. I had an opportunity to hear International Vice President Gudrun Yngvadottir speak. Next year, she will be the first female President of Lions Club International. I was impressed.
