We (FLD Molly, Lion Sheryl and I) look forward to seeing all of you in Columbus!

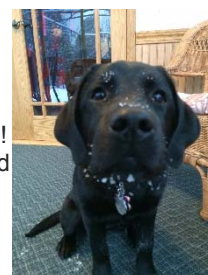
Molly's Corner:

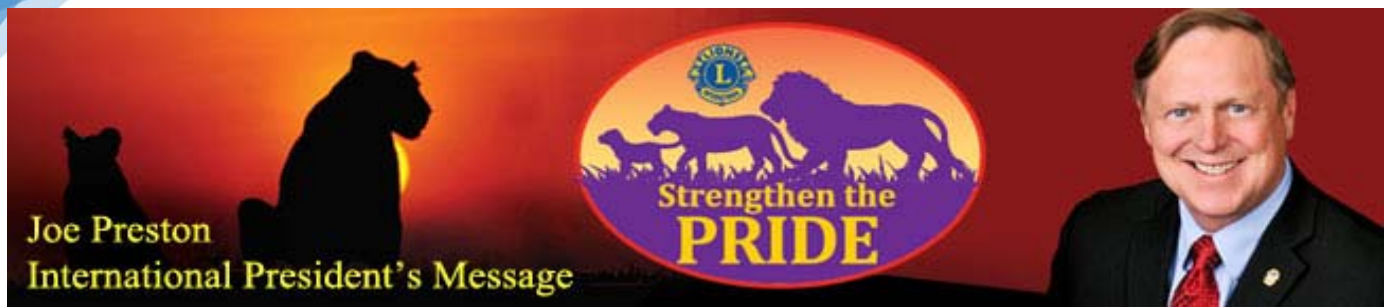

Special Projects October 2014

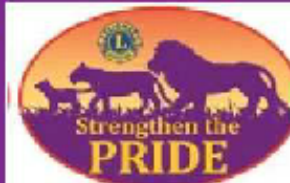

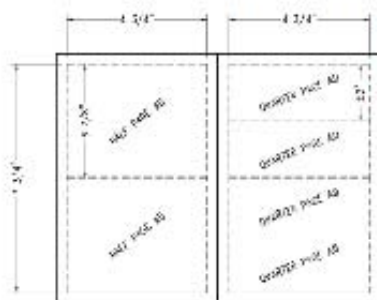
