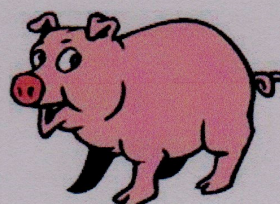
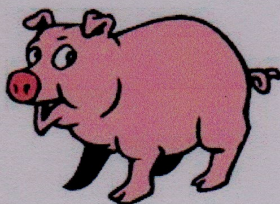


The New Haven Lions Club held two cookouts, the first on August 15th and the second on August 29th. We cooked chicken halves and slabs of baby back ribs.
