### Enhance the experience of your meetings

People join Lions clubs because they are passionate about service, so it's important to ensure service is your club's central focus — even in meetings. The following tips can help you run effective meetings that keep Young Lions engaged and excited about your club, while also keeping sight of your club's main goal: to serve.

#### **General meeting tips**

- Start and end meetings on time, and be aware of the limited time of parents of young and school-age children.
  - If the meeting is scheduled for an hour and goes over that time, make it known and allow members to leave if they must.
- · Keep meetings brief and efficient.
  - Officers and committees can meet separately before or after the club meeting. The most successful clubs keep their meetings to an hour or less.
- Schedule time at the beginning of each meeting for new ideas.
- Make service a part of every meeting.
  - Celebrate your service accomplishments. Show photos and share thank you notes. Plan easy service tasks that can be completed during meetings.
- Consider online meetings when possible, or allow members to join live meetings by using an online platform.

- Do not serve formal meals. Snacks are welcomed, but plan social events, such as formal meals, separately from your meeting.
- · Have a plan to keep club members' children occupied.
  - Assign someone to help with homework, lead coloring/craft projects, or lead school-age children in planning a service event for local children in need. Visit **lionsclubs.org/family-membership** to explore helpful ways to guide and mentor children in your club with The Family Cub Program.
- Create excitement about upcoming events and celebrate each member's contributions.

#### **Involve Young Lions**

- Allow Young Lions to help lead and run the meeting.
- Use the social media skills of your club's Young Lions to promote service events and reach out to prospective Young Lion members — their networking and social media knowledge is a great benefit to your club!
- Ask Young Lions about service initiatives that are important to them.
- Allow Young Lions to plan service projects that they are passionate about.

### Diabetes

- 1. Organize a "Strides: Lions for Diabetes Awareness" event.
- 2. Organize a community support group for parents of children with diabetes.
- 3. Volunteer to serve at a children's diabetes camp.

- 5. Partner with local healthcare providers to organize diabetes & vision screenings.
- 6. Distribute educational resources to increase diabetes awareness at a community health fair.
- 7. Organize a walking club for seniors with diabetes.
- 8. Provide a diabetes magazine subscription to your local library.
- 9. Sponsor a child in need to attend diabetes camp.
- 10. Donate diabetes books to your library with a bookplate to identify your club's donation.
- 11. Work with your local school to invite a health care professional to speak about diabetes.
- 12. Post monthly articles about diabetes on your club or district website.
- 13. Promote diabetes prevention through a radio public service announcement.
- 14. Sponsor a healthy cooking demonstration for people with diabetes.
- 15. Organize a school or community vegetable garden to encourage healthy eating.
- 16. Work with a community podiatrist or foot care specialist to provide foot screenings.
- 17. Partner with your local diabetes organization to offer programs & materials.
- Promote community resources and online materials from LCI partners NDEP, DECA & IDF.
- 19. Promote the importance of an annual dilated eye exam to detect diabetic eye disease.

The following is the first of three parts on Domain Names - Get One

and Keep It!

### Part #1 - What is a Domain Name and Why Does my Club/District Need One?

A domain name is an important component of any modern-day club/district, especially in this new digital age. A domain name is something used by a club/district to identify your website. Even if you have a FREE club/district website through Lions Clubs International, your custom domain name helps to identify your club/district AND (when chosen correctly) will be easy to use in your club/district marketing materials.

In order to obtain a domain name for your club/district, you must purchase your domain name from an authorized Domain Name Registrar. There are many companies out there, but we strongly suggest using one of the popular and long-standing registrars: Domain.com (domain.com); GoDaddy (godaddy.com); Network Solutions (networksolutions.com).

Purchasing a domain name is an annual purchase (although many registrars offer a multi-year purchase option). The price of a domain name will vary slightly from registrar to registrar but on average the cost will be between \$7-15 per year. The best type of domain to purchase is always one with a .com extension but in the case of a Lions club/district, a .org extension is also a good selection.

Once your club/district has decided on which registrar to use and has selected a domain name that best fits your local club/district, it's time to set everything up properly. We'll cover these issues in Topic #2 of the series in a future newsletter.
