#### Official Minutes District 25-G Meeting Atwood Community Building in Atwood, Indiana July 28, 2018

The first District 25-G meeting for 2018-2019 took place at Atwood Community Building. It was hosted by the Atwood Lions Club, serving many breakfast items at 8:30 a.m. Name tags , July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019 District 25-G budget, as well as banking summary (year to date) , along with the agenda for the meeting were provided at the check-in table.

#### Call to Order and Introduction

DG Jim Reeve called the meeting to order at 9:03, thanking all for attending. First Vice District Governor Mary Klempay also gave opening welcome remarks, with 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice District Governor, Brian Thomas, leading all in the Pledge. Prayer was given by Lion Kim Polk.

DG Jim also had all PDG's stand and be recognized. Also DG Jim explained committee rules reporting and introduced Sergeant-at-arms, Keith Claassen.

#### **Recognition of Attendees**

CS Lion Duane Griner called the roll of clubs in attendance. Forty Lions representing 16 different clubs were present. There were no guests in attendance.

#### **Committee Reports**

Please accept my apology in advance as I am only going to list those committee reports that were given at the meeting, rather than listing all and saying "No report."

**Convention**: International Convention will be in Milan, Italy in 2019. More Information will be provided at a later date. Mid-winter Conference will be at Crown Plaza, Indianapolis Airport on January 11 and 12.

**GST**: Lion Al Beehler stated that all club activities need to be reported to International. He mentioned that former President Jimmy Carter will be at Notre Dame for a humanitarian project, working with Lions on August 26, 2018, 5:00 to 6:00 p.m.

**LCIF:** PDG Marty Juel stated that "Campaign 100" will kick off shortly. More details will be provided later. LCIF plans on raising over \$300,000,000 over the next three years. There will be different programs, and some may have grants available.

**Law Camp**: 1<sup>st</sup> VDG Mary Kempay stated there has been over \$1,000 donated for the program. August 25, 2018 is next meeting date.

**Environmental:** Lion Duane Griner reported the committee will be sponsoring a photo contest and awarding prizes. More information will be provided later. Encourage your club members and Leos to be taking pictures for this contest.

**Eye Bank**: PDG Bob Meyers reported progress is continuing in securing the new building. It is sponsoring the annual "Celebration of Life" program.

#### DG Thoughts - "Get On Board"


