Greetings from the Indiana Lions Foundation,

As you may know, the Indiana Lions Foundation is the state organization which:

- Awards Indiana Lions Clubs a \$750.00 Grants for projects
- Distributes W. P. Woods Awards
- Sponsors Indiana Lions License Plates
- Presents the Indiana Distinguished Lion Award
- **Manage the Indiana Lions State Office Building**

The Indiana Lions State Office Building is located at 8780 Purdue Road in Indianapolis. The Foundation is responsible for the management and upkeep of the building. There is no cost for the management or use of the building passed on to Indiana Lions. The State Office Building is a vital asset to Indiana Lions and is used daily for many training and administrative functions.

As with any building, repairs are a common occurrence. Currently, the building is in need of landscaping improvements. In conjunction with the improvements proposed, an Indiana Lions brick Plaza is also being planned.

This Plaza will be an aesthetically significant memorial to Indiana Lions that will greet visitors as they enter the building. The Plaza is designed to accommodate personalized Engraved Brick pavers. **The goal of the Indiana Lions Foundation is to have all Indiana Lions Clubs represented in the Plaza with an Engraved Brick. The cost per Engraved Brick is \$100.00, a double brick is \$250.00. Each Club Brick will be placed within the district the Club currently resides.**

Additionally, Engraved Bricks are available to individual Lions or Lion organizations. Attempts will be made to group Engraved Bricks by category. (PDG's, Indiana ID's, State Projects, Memorial Bricks etc.)

Please consider supporting the Indiana Lions State Office Building by purchasing an Engraved Brick for this very worthwhile showcase of Indiana Lions. Bricks may be purchased for your Lions Club, a Lions organization or an individual Lion.

Enclosed you will find an Engraved Brick application as well as a preliminary drawing of the Plaza. Each Engraved Brick paver can accommodate 3 lines of 13 characters (including spaces). Double bricks can accommodate 6 lines of 13 characters. Construction of the Plaza will commence in April 2013. To be included in the initial build out, your application will need to be returned by February 15, 2013.
