Zone Meetings:

In order to share last year's results with A-3 Lions, I have attended Zone Meetings for Zones 10 Centre in Peterborough, Zone 10 South in Port Hope, Zone 43 South in Stirling, and Zone 43 North in Marmora Crowe Valley. At the meeting certificates were given to each Vision Screening Team and Banner patches given to Lions and Lioness clubs with active Vision Screening teams and also to those who supported the programme financially. When speaking to Lions, I am asking that each club consider putting Vision Screening in their budget yearly.
