

COIN MARKS LIONS INTERANTIONAL'S 100 ANNIVERSARY

Lions Clubs International is celebrating this year 100 years of worldwide community service. With a membership of 1.4 million people in more than 47,000 clubs providing humanitarian services throughout the world, Lions Clubs International is one of the world's largest organizations of its kind.

To commemorate this anniversary, the U.S. Mint has issued a Proof silver dollar. The obverse


