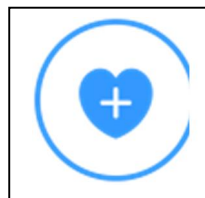

She and Lion Gord have been married since 1969, and have two adult children and two fabulous grandchildren.

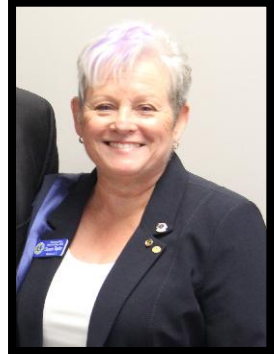

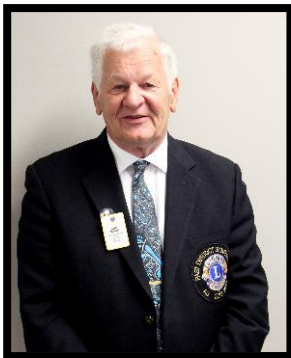
