Gudrun Yngvadottir, from Gardabaer, Iceland, was elected to serve as international president of Lions Clubs International at the association's 101st International Convention, held in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA, June 29 through July 3, 2018.

International President Yngvadottir is a biomedical scientist and has worked in research, education and management. Since 1990 she has worked at the University of Iceland as Vice Director at the Institute of Continuing Education.

A member of the Gardabaejar Eik Lions Club since 1992, President Yngvadottir has held many offices within the association, including district governor council chairperson. She has dedicated her service to children and youth, membership and leadership development, health and wellness, including vision and diabetes, environmental projects and Lions Clubs International Foundation (LCIF).

President Yngvadottir served as international director 2010-2012 on the Leadership Committee, as chairperson the second year; 2011-2013 on the Women's Task Force; 2012-2013 she was aboard appointee on the District and Club Service Committee; and 2013-2014 on LCIF Governance Ad Hoc Committee.

In recognition of her service, she has received numerous awards including the Kjarans Medal, the highest award of Icelandic Lions; the Lions Crystal, the highest award of Norwegian Lions; several Membership and Extension Awards; eleven International President's Awards; and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest Lions Clubs International award. She is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow. In addition to her Lions activities, President Yngvadottir is active in numerous professional and community organizations, including the Icelandic Association of Biomedical Scientists and has been its representative for cooperation between Scandinavian and European scientists.

President Yngvadottir and her husband, Dr. Jon Bjarni Thorsteinsson, a past international director and a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow, have one son, one daughter and six grandchildren.

DISTRICT A-3 VISITATION CONTEST 2018/19

The purpose of this contest is to enhance the fun and fellowship aspect of Lions. It is hoped that by instilling a bit of competition, members from the various clubs in each Region will reach out and get to know their fellow Lions in neighboring clubs and that ideas and inspiration can be shared.

Plaques (or Certificates depending on available finances) will be awarded for the most Club Visits and most cumulative member points awarded for:

- ✓ Clubs with 29 or less members
- ✓ Clubs with 30 or more members, and
- ✓ The New Lion and Lion who accumulate the most points for visiting the most clubs, the greatest number of times. (the New Lion is a Lion inducted after January 1, 2018).

Some basic rules will be in place to ensure fairness and provide that bit of challenge to make this a fun competition.

1. District officers making official visits are not eligible to collect points or be counted towards the minimum as set out in Rule 7 below.
2. Lions who accompany District officers on their official visits can accumulate points. Rule 7 below applies.
3. For Zone, Region or Cabinet meetings, points for members of the District Advisory Committee, as outlined in the District Constitution, will receive half points. All other Lions attending will accumulate points as per Rule 9 below.
4. Points will not be awarded for distance travelled.
5. Points can be accumulated for visits to any Club in the District.
6. No points will be awarded for visits outside the District; however, if someone visits a club outside the District they will get special mention when the prizes are awarded.
7. For a visit to qualify as a Club visit, the minimum number of Lions (eligible to collect points) attending is as follows:
 - a) Clubs of 29 members or less – 2 Club members
 - b) Clubs of 30 or more members – 3 Club members
8. Contest runs from September 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019.
9. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - a) Club Visit – 1 point for each Club visited (can only be accumulated once). Only one visit per meeting night will qualify.

- b) Club Executive:
 - i) 5 points per regular Club visit
 - ii) 5 points per Zone, Region or Cabinet meeting
 - c) Regular Lions:
 - i) 5 points per regular Club visit
 - ii) 10 points per Zone, Region or Cabinet meeting
 - d) New Lions (inducted after January 1, 2018)
 - i) 10 points per regular Club visit
 - ii) 20 points per Zone, Region or Cabinet meeting
10. Visit reports to be sent via email to the Region Chair no later than the end of the month in which the visit occurred. Visit reports are to include date of visit, name of Lions Club visited, names of Lions who visited including their Club titles, indicating any New Lions.
 11. Since we have Leos in the Region, all points noted above apply to Leo members as well.
 12. Pilfering of Club paraphernalia is not encouraged; however, if you wish to play that game to ensure reciprocal visitations, please restrict it to small items if intrinsic vs monetary value. Zone, Regions and Cabinet meetings are off limits for these acts.
 13. All reports will be kept by the Region Chair and his/her decision on matters relating to the contest will be final.

It is GREAT TO BE LIONS, so let's get out, have some fun and see what our fellow Lions are up to.
