The Canton Lions Club ended this year with many service projects to complete a year of “We Serve.” At the July 8 meeting, in-coming Lion president Cody Brantley and Lion Service Chair, Sandra Giles presented a \$400 check to Debbie Brinkley, executive Director of Hope Pregnancy Center. Funds were raised by donations from Canton Lions.

Other projects include the Spirit of Christmas Food Drive. In partnership with Brookshire's, Rotary, students from Canton schools, Canton Lions delivered 410 boxes of food to needy families in the area. This project was led by Vice President Lace Deibert.

In January, Canton Lions held a "Pajama Party." With the help of the Canton NHS and Canton Leos Club, 52 pairs of pajamas were donated to children in our area through the Children's Advocacy Center.

In October of 2019, Canton Lions raised \$250, used to purchase 25 cases of food for the Canton ISD Backpack program. This project sends home food with students who need help getting enough food for the weekend.

In February, the "Wash Off" project was held. Members donated \$220 plus assorted items to buy soap, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrushes, deodorant, etc. which were distributed through Manna to those who need help. Lion Benja Mize began this project several years ago.

This spring, even though meetings were shut down, Canton Lions were able to give ten \$1000 scholarships to graduating seniors from Canton ISD, Martins Mill ISD, and Wills Point ISD.

The Canton Lions just completed an extraordinarily successful year of "We Serve" under the leadership of president Lion Judge Josh Wintters and chair Sandra Giles.

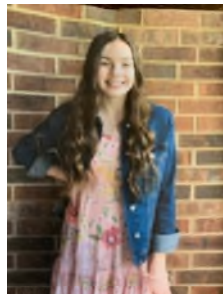

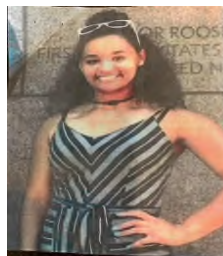
