

REQUIREMENTS

Guiding Lions are encouraged to become certified by successfully passing the Certified Guiding Lion Course prior to appointment. The Certified Guiding Lions Program is designed to assist clubs that are newly chartered, established or designated as priority clubs.

Guiding Lions are assigned for a two-year term by the district governor in consultation with the sponsoring or established club president. Guiding Lions are limited to serving no more than two new clubs at any point in time.

Guiding Lions assist a club to:

- Be successful in its first two years of operation
 - Orient and train club officers and members
- Motivate and support club growth and development
- Locate resources available to assist the club

The course is designed to be completed individually or facilitated by an instructor. All Certified Guiding Lions are required to take the Certified Guiding Lion (CGL) course every three years.

MISSION STATEMENT

To empower volunteers to serve their communities, meet humanitarian needs, encourage peace and promote international understanding through Lions clubs.

LIONS INTERNATIONAL PURPOSES

- To ORGANIZE, charter and supervise service clubs to be known as Lions clubs.
- To COORDINATE the activities and standardize the administration of Lions clubs.
- To CREATE and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world.
- To PROMOTE the principles of good government and good citizenship.
- To TAKE an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.
- To UNITE the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.
- To PROVIDE a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by club members.
- To ENCOURAGE service-minded people to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.

LIONS CODE OF ETHICS

- TO SHOW my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that may merit a reputation for quality of service.
- TO SEEK success and to demand all fair remuneration or profit as my just due, but to accept no profit or success at the price of my own self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.
- TO REMEMBER that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself.
- WHENEVER a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action towards others, to resolve such doubt against myself.
- TÓ HOLD friendship as an end and not as a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given.
- ALWAYS to bear in mind my obligations as a citizen to my nation, my state, and my community, as to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act, and deed, to give them freely of my time, labor and means.
- TO AID others by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.
- TO BE CAREFUL with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL's FOUNDER



Melvin Jones was born on January 13, 1879 in Fort Thomas, Arizona, the son of a United States Army captain who commanded a troop of scouts. Later, his father was transferred, and the family moved east. As a young man, Jones made his home in Chicago, Illinois, became associated with an insurance firm and in 1913 formed his own agency.

He soon joined the Business Circle, a businessmen's luncheon group, and was shortly elected secretary. This group was one of many at that time devoted solely to promoting the financial interests of their membership. Because of their limited appeal, they were destined to disappear. Melvin Jones, however, had other plans. "What if these men," he asked, "who are successful because of their drive, intelligence and ambition, were to put their talents to work improving their communities?" Thus, at his invitation, delegates from men's clubs met in Chicago to lay the groundwork for such an organization and on June 7, 1917, Lions Clubs International

Melvin Jones eventually abandoned his insurance agency to devote himself full time to Lions at International Headquarters in Chicago. It was under his dynamic leadership that Lions Clubs earned the prestige necessary to attract civic-minded members.

The association's founder was also recognized as a leader outside the association. One of his greatest honors was in 1945 when he represented Lions Clubs International as a consultant in San Francisco, California, at the organization of the United Nations.

Melvin Jones, the man whose personal code "You can't get very far until you start doing something for somebody else," became a guiding principle for public-spirited people the world over, died June 1, 1961 at 82 years of age. 

- (a) Semi-annual membership dues of twenty-one dollars and fifty cents (US \$21.50) denominated in U.S. dollars shall be levied on each club member based upon the membership of each club as shown by its membership report of June and December and shall be paid by each club to the International Office be determined by the International Board of Directors, except as provided in subscriptions (b) and (c) herein
- (b) For family membership programs as adopted by the International Board of Directors, the following dues shall apply:
 - (1) The first family member shall pay semi-annual membership dues as provided in sub-section (a) above
 - (2) Subsequent qualifying family members, not to exceed four additional qualifying members per household, shall pay semi-annual membership dues equal to one-half (1/2) of the total amount paid by the first family member as described in subsection (b)(1) above.
- (c) For student membership programs as adopted by the International Board of Directors, eligible student members shall pay semi-annual membership dues equal to one-half (1/2) of the total amount of dues as provided in sub-section (a) above.

DISTRICT HALL OF FAME

The District Governor shall call for nomination for the District Hall of Fame. The following procedure should be followed:

- 4. The final selection by the District Governor's committee will be made 5 days prior to the Mid-Winter Conference.
- 5. Cost of the Hall of Fame award will be billed to the nominating club.
- 6. Any inductee into the Texas Lions Hall of Fame will automatically become a member of the District Hall of Fame.
- 7. Proper presentation ceremony should take place at the District Convention.
- 8. Solicitation in any manner for this recognition will
- automatically eliminate the soliciting candidate for that year.


