You *must* register for the Convention, either online or by using this form, *even if you are not ordering tickets to any events.* This form may be reproduced as needed.

The form may be used by an individual registrant or a couple purchasing tickets or registering together. **Do not use this form for more than two people**. Forms with more than two names will be returned. *Note that online registration will require that each person register separately.*

If you are not using online registration, this order form and funds are to be sent to the Convention Committee Treasurer, PCC Wayne Cole, 2640 Meadowbrook, Federalsburg, MD 21632. *Payment must accompany ticket orders*.

Meal Tickets – Meal tickets are for the Multiple District Banquet, Past District Governor Breakfast, District Luncheon, Hospitality BBQ and the Victory Luncheon. All ticket requests **must be received by April 1, 2025**.

Tail Twister Sticker - For \$10 per registrant, you can order a tail twister sticker to provide exemption from tail twister fines at each event.

Online registration includes an option to pay with your credit card. If you are not registering online, you may only use Check or Money Order for the meal tickets and tail twister stickers ordered. Orders without payment will be returned. Orders may be grouped and covered by one check (preferably a club check); however, each participant must have an individual registration form.
