LionsClub Dues

All Club dues shall be paid from the Club's Administration Account.

LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL (LCI) Clubs are billed twice a year in July and January based on Membership records at June 30th and December 31th. Numbers are based on the MMR (Monthly Membership Report) entered online in MyLion by your club secretary.

There are several ways for your club secretary to pay for your LCI dues.

For Lions Club International dues questions, please contact Accounts Receivable and Club Account Services, direct e-mail address: accountsreceivable@lionsclubs.org or direct Fax Number: 1-630-571-1683

1. LIONS "PRE-AUTHORIZATION FORM": Payments can be made by using the "Pre-authorization Form". See form on next page. The amount will automatically be withdrawn from your Lions' Club bank account. This form can be found on our district website.

2. CLUB PAYMENTS VIA CREDIT CARD: Club Treasurers may pay by credit card via MyLCI on the Lions Club International website (www.lionsclubs.org).

MULTIPLE DISTRICT "A" (M.D. "A") and DISTRICT A-9 DUES are combined and billed once a year on September 10th based on the number of members according to LCI records as of July 1st. Payments are to be mailed to the District A-9 Cabinet Treasurer at the address set out on the dues invoice.

Canada Pre-Authorize Debit Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Should I expect to submit the Pre-Authorized Debit Agreement form more than once?

A: No, you only need to submit the form once, unless your banking information has changed, or your club no longer wishes to approve electronic payments.

Q: Who can process the pre-authorized debit?

A: The pre-authorized debit is processed at the LCI Office in Oak Brook after club approval is received.

Q: Must I call every time I want the ACH debit to be processed?

A: Yes, you must notify us each time you would like the debit to be processed. You may contact Accounts Receivable at accountsreceivable@lionsclubs.org, or by fax 630-571-1683.

Q: Who determines the amount to be processed?
A: The Club Officers determine the amount and date to be processed, The approval must be received in writing.

Q: Will the electronic payment be issued in CAD?

A: Yes, the electronic payment will be issued in Canadian Dollars.

Q: What rate will be used for the payment?

A: The rate will be reflected on your club statement.

Q: Can clubs initiate the ACH on the Lions Website?

A: No, the approved ACH process allows us to debit the club bank accounts. The Accounts Receivable Department must initiate the payment.

Q: Can ACH payments be processed for Multiple District and District Accounts too?

A: Yes, ACH payments can be processed for club, district, and multiple district accounts.

Lioness History

The Lioness Program started in 1975 officially recognizing women as a valuable part of Lionism. The program grew until 1987 when Lions Clubs officially accepted women into their clubs. District A-9 had 14 Lioness clubs at its peak and only 4 Lioness clubs when it was no longer recognized by Lions International in 2021. Luckily a lot of our Lionesses joined Lions clubs and continue to serve our communities.



The Flag Code

When flags of two or more nations are displayed they should be flown from separate staffs of the same height and the flags should be of approximately equal size. International usage forbids the display of the flag of one nation above that of another nation in time of peace.

When the flag is displayed otherwise than by being flown from a staff, it should be displayed flat, whether indoors or out, or so suspended that its folds fall free as though the flag were staffed.

When used on a speaker's platform, the flag, if displayed flat, should be displayed above and behind the speaker.

When three flags are flown together, the Canadian flag should occupy the central position, with the next ranking flag to the left and third ranking to the right, as seen by the spectators in front of the flags.

When displayed from a staff in a church or public auditorium, the flag of Canada should hold the position of superior prominence, in advance of the audience, and in the position of honour at the clergyman's' or speakers' right as he faces the audience. Any other flag so displayed should be placed on the left of the clergyman or speaker or to the right of the audience.

When used in connection with the unveiling of a statue or monument, the flag should form a distinctive feature during the ceremony, but the flag itself should never be used as the covering for the statue.

Communication Procedures on the Death of a Lion

When a Lion member dies, the Club President or other responsible member should obtain the following information from the family of the deceased.

- 1) Name, location and phone number of the Funeral Home.
- 2) If a Lions ceremony is to be held, time and date.
- 3) Order of dress - vest, business suit, official Lion's dress, etc.
- 4) Time, place and date of funeral.
- 5) Special family requests.

The Club President or designate should offer the Lions Memorial Service to the family. Suggest to the family that this is non-denominational and brief. It can be held either before or after the visitations so that it doesn't interfere. This is a chance for our Lions family who served with the deceased an opportunity to honour them. This service may be conducted by the District Governor, District Officers or Club Members. It is suggested that Club Members close to the family be involved.
