## DISTRICT GOALS 2018-2019

Prior to becoming District Governor, the First Vice District Governor receives training, which includes a requirement to set goals for his/her year as Governor. **THIS YEAR'S DISTRICT GOALS ARE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The main goal this year is **RETENTION** of our current membership. We need to reduce the number of dropped members for reasons other than by death. If each club recruits only 1 new member each we would have 55 of the 80 new members which is our goal. Think about it and get out and just ask 1 person you know to join.

2. To start at least 1 new club of 20 members or more.
3. To start at least 1 Branch club of at least 5 members. This could be a specialty club (organized around Diabetes, Pediatric Cancer, Service, a "cyber" club etc).

4. We need to increase the percentage of women Lions in District 14-C – the goal is to be over 19% by July 2, 2019.
5. We need to have more Guiding Lions. At least two (2) Lions need to receive Guiding Lion certification.

6. Training – If someone in your club needs training contact your Zone Chair or check out the online training offered by Lions Club International

7. Every club will participate in a same-day district-wide service project.

The above goals will require the commitment of the district's leadership team and the enthusiastic support of our clubs. In order to encourage clubs and individuals to work toward achieving these goals, the District Governor has established a "challenge program" to recognize clubs and individuals who meet specific criteria.

Clubs and individuals will be recognized for the following:

- Meet the criteria for LCI's *Club Excellence Award*
- Recruitment of the most new members in a club
- The club with the greatest percentage increase in membership.
- Clubs who's President and Secretary attend at least 3 Cabinet Meetings
- Clubs who have more than 5 members attend the District Convention.
- The Zone Chair with the greatest percentage increase in membership.
- Leo of the Year.

# DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S PROJECTS FUND

Each year the District Governor ask clubs to donate money to support the specific district, state, and LCI projects. The recommended donation made by clubs this year is \$25 per member.

It is customary to present checks to the Governor during the District Governor's visit to your club. If a club cannot make a donation at the time of the Governor's visit, a check can be mailed to the District Treasurer.

This year's donations to the District Governor's Project Fund will distributed as follows, unless otherwise directed by the donating club:

## Club Donations and Payments

All checks submitted to the district, whether for the District Governor's Projects fund, for payment of dues, or for some other purpose, must be made payable to LCI District 14-C and contain a notation on the memo line to indicate the purpose of the donation.

*NOTE: Club donations to a specific organization or agency should be made payable, and mailed directly, to the organization or agency selected without directing the funds through the District Treasurer.*

## PROTOCOL

What is “protocol?” A humorist defined it as the “science of the seats” because the term is often applied to the seating arrangements of officers, dignitaries, and guests. In our International organization, we sincerely try to respect rank, which is the basis of discipline and is the basis of a perfectly organized society.

We do not subscribe to “protocol” because of a desire to outshine, but rather to prove that we are organized and have respect for the fundamental concepts of a discipline that we have imposed upon ourselves voluntarily. Protocol, therefore is the order of precedence that must be established in any organization.

### Protocol for District Governor’s Visit

The office of the District Governor is the highest ranking authority within your district. The Lion who holds this office was chosen because of his/her talents and dedication to Lionism. Accordingly, proper recognition and respect for the Lion who holds this office requires the careful attention of clubs within the district. The following list of suggestions may prove helpful:

1. The program for this official visitation will be the District Governor’s message. ***No other program other than normal club business shall be scheduled for this meeting.***
  2. The club president should greet the District Governor upon arrival. The president (or designee) should have the members meet and greet the governor.
  3. When the District Governor is introduced, the members should rise and applaud, and should do so again at the conclusion of his/her presentation.
  4. Even though the District Governor will be a good sport, the tail twister, in good taste, should respect the individual and the position.
  5. The District Governor will meet with the Board of Directors immediately after the meeting to discuss mutual concerns.
  6. Discuss club problems with your District Governor. It is his/her job to help solve problems and suggest new ideas.
  7. Head Table Seating Arrangement  
President- Center or left of rostrum; District Governor- on President’s right; Zone Chair- on District Governor’s right  
Other club officers are seated at the discretion of the President.
1. Introduction- Head table-President introduces Zone Chair, Zone Chair introduces District Governor and, if in attendance, Vice-District Governor.

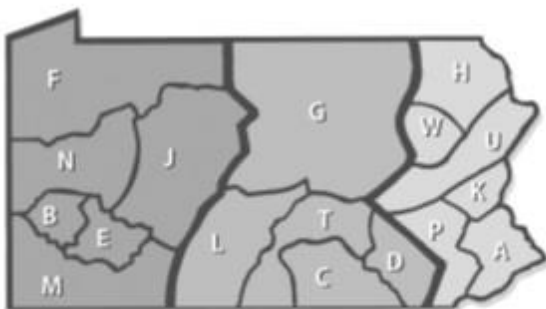

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Flag and Banner Display**

The AMERICAN FLAG should be displayed during all club meetings at the President's right as he/she faces the group.

The CLUB BANNER should be displayed during all club meetings at President's left as he/she faces the group or directly behind the rostrum.

### **Induction and Installation Ceremonies**

To ensure a dignified and impressive procedure, in line with proper protocol, the District Governor, Vice District Governor, Past District Governor, or any qualified member of the District Cabinet should perform these ceremonies. However, current or past Presidents may also perform the ceremony.

### **Awarding of Special Presentations**

To avoid unnecessary and lengthy ceremonies, the proper format should be followed when presenting awards and making presentations. These presentations should be entrusted to a qualified officer of a club or another district dignitary.

### **Directory Changes and Corrections**

Send all changes and corrections to the District Governor and Newsletter Editor. Submitted items will be published in a subsequent District Newsletter.

### **Collections**

The district collects and recycles used eyeglasses, hearing aids, and cell phones. Items collected by clubs should be taken to cabinet meeting. District personnel sort these and deliver them to appropriate locations, where they can be put to good use. Items may also be given to the District Governor, Vice District Governor, or Zone Chair during a club visit.

Please note that inside the ear models of hearing aids cannot be used

## Reporting to Lions Clubs International

Club Secretaries should update club membership and club activities periodically using MyLCI (see LCI on-line instructions). Ideally, updates should be made monthly during the last 5 days of the month. At a minimum, reporting should occur quarterly during the last 5 days of September, December, March, and June.

*It is important to note that membership information for billing purposes is extracted from MyLCI on July 1st and January 1st. Clubs are responsible to pay dues for members based on the data extracted from MyLCI on those dates.*

New officers should be reported using MyLCI, preferably before, but no later than, May 20th of each year. Prompt reporting allows for notification of new officers by District and LCI personnel regarding training and proper listing in the district directory.

Questions regarding the use of MyLCI should be directed to the District Administrator.
