DISTRICT GOALS 2025-2026

Prior to becoming District Governor, the First Vice District Governor receives training, which includes a requirement to set goals for their year as Governor. These goals are set through consultation with the district's leadership team, which includes the District Governor, Vice-District Governors, Zone Chairs, and others. This year's district goals are as follows:

1. District 14-C will start 1 new club with at least 20 charter members, will induct 126 new members into existing clubs for a net gain of +5
2. District 14-C will meet or exceed the 2024-2025 reporting percentage. Goal is to have at least 95% of clubs reporting service activities.
3. District 14-C will donate at least \$37,000 to LCIF with 100% club participation.
4. District 14-C will conduct Club Officer and Zone Chair training plus new member and sponsor orientations. All training will be reported by the District GLT Coordinator using LI reporting tools. District will also promote Lions University, RLLI, LI LEARN and other training opportunities at symposiums and forums.
5. District 14-C will plan and hold three service events with a focus on: the environment partnering with organizations like Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay; Diabetes Awareness, partnering with local hospitals; and Childhood Cancer, partnering with Four Diamonds.

This is an ambitious set of goals, which will require the commitment of the district's leadership team and the enthusiastic support of our clubs. Clubs that demonstrate their support for this year's District Goals will be recognized with a Certificate of Achievement from the District Governor.

PROTOCOL

What is "protocol?" A humorist defined it as the "science of the seats" because the term is often applied to the seating arrangements of officers, dignitaries, and guests. In our International organization, we sincerely try to respect rank, which is the basis of discipline and is the basis of a perfectly organized society.

We do not subscribe to "protocol" because of a desire to outshine, but rather to prove that we are organized and have respect for the fundamental concepts of a discipline that we have imposed upon ourselves voluntarily. Protocol, therefore is the order of precedence that must be established in any organization.

Protocol for District Governor's Visit

The office of the District Governor is the highest ranking authority within your district. The Lion who holds this office was chosen because of his/her talents and dedication to Lionism. Accordingly, proper recognition and respect for the Lion who holds this office requires the careful attention of clubs within the district. The following list of suggestions may prove helpful:

1. The program for this official visitation will be the District Governor's message. No other program other than normal club business shall be scheduled for this meeting.
2. The club president should greet the District Governor upon arrival. The president (or designee) should have the members meet and greet the governor.
3. When the District Governor is introduced, the members should rise and applaud, and should do so again at the conclusion of his/her presentation.
4. Even though the District Governor will be a good sport, the tail twister, in good taste, should respect the individual and the position.
5. The District Governor may wish to meet with the Board of Directors immediately after the meeting to discuss mutual concerns.
6. Discuss club problems with your District Governor. It is his/her job to help solve problems and suggest new ideas.
7. Head Table Seating Arrangement
 - President - Center or left of rostrum
 - District Governor - on President's right
 - Zone Chair - on District Governor's right

- Other club officers are seated at the discretion of the President.
8. Introduction - Head Table
- President introduces Zone Chair
 - Zone Chair introduces District Governor and, if in attendance, Vice-District Governor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Flag and Banner Display

The AMERICAN FLAG should be displayed during all club meetings at the President's right as he/she faces the group.

The CLUB BANNER should be displayed during all club meetings at President's left as he/she faces the group or directly behind the rostrum.

Induction and Installation Ceremonies

To ensure a dignified and impressive procedure, in line with proper protocol, the District Governor, Vice District Governor, Past District Governor, or any qualified member of the District Cabinet should perform these ceremonies. However, current or past presidents may also perform the ceremony.

Awards and Special Presentations

To avoid unnecessary and lengthy ceremonies, the proper format should be followed when presenting awards and making presentations. Their presentations should be entrusted to a qualified officer of a club or another district dignitary.

Directory Changes and Corrections

Send all changes and corrections to the District Governor and Newsletter Editor. Submitted items will be published in a subsequent District Newsletter.

Collections

The district collects and recycles used eye glasses, hearing aids, and cell phones. Items collected by clubs should be taken to cabinet meetings. District personnel sort these items and deliver them to appropriate locations, where they can be put to good use. Items may also be given to the District Governor, Vice District Governor, or Zone Chair during a club visit or Zone Advisory meeting. Please note that inside-the-ear models of hearing aids cannot be used.

LCI, MD-14 and District 14-C Dues

Lions Club members pay dues to cover the administrative costs associated with running the international organization, their multiple district, their district, and their club. Dues paid to the international organization, multiple district and district result in services and programs that help support clubs and provide training for club leaders. Online courses, informational videos and brochures, easy-to-complete templates, websites and social media platforms are just a few examples of the many resource available to club leaders and members.

The chart below shows the annual fees clubs pay to Lions Clubs International, Multiple District 14, and District 14-C. Clubs typically include an additional fee in their dues assessment to cover the club's operating costs. For new members, there is a \$35 entrance fee, which may be paid by the member or the club.

Reporting to Lions International

Club Secretaries or Club Administrators should update club membership and activities periodically using the ***Lion Portal***.

Use ***Lion Portal*** to manage your club membership, create/update your club's profile, check club voter eligibility, check club account balances and check status of Club Branch, New Lions Club or new Leo Club applications.

Also use the ***Lion Portal*** to report service activities, plan service projects, connect with other Lions, view club data, access training and create a personal profile. The ***Lion Portal*** can be accessed through the LI website (lionsclubs.org).

Any Lion can set up a ***Lion Portal*** account. To gain access to the ***Lion Portal***, you must first set up a user name and password. To do so, you will need to provide your membership number and the same email address your Club Secretary has on file with LCI. Members can update their personal information once they have set up a ***Lion Portal*** account.

Club Presidents, Secretaries and Administrators are the club officers who have the ability to edit club and member information in the *Lion Portal*. Ideally, updates on club membership and activities should be made monthly during the last 5 days of the month. At a minimum, reporting should occur quarterly during the last 5 days of September, December, March, and June.

PLEASE NOTE - Membership information for billing purposes is extracted from the *Lion Portal* on July 1st and January 1st. Clubs are responsible to pay dues for members based on the data extracted from the *Lion Portal* on those dates.

New officers should be reported using the *Lion Portal*, preferably before, but no later than, May 20th of each year. Prompt reporting allows for notification of new officers by District and LCI personnel regarding training and proper listing in the district directory.

Questions regarding the use of the *Lion Portal* should be directed to the District Administrator.

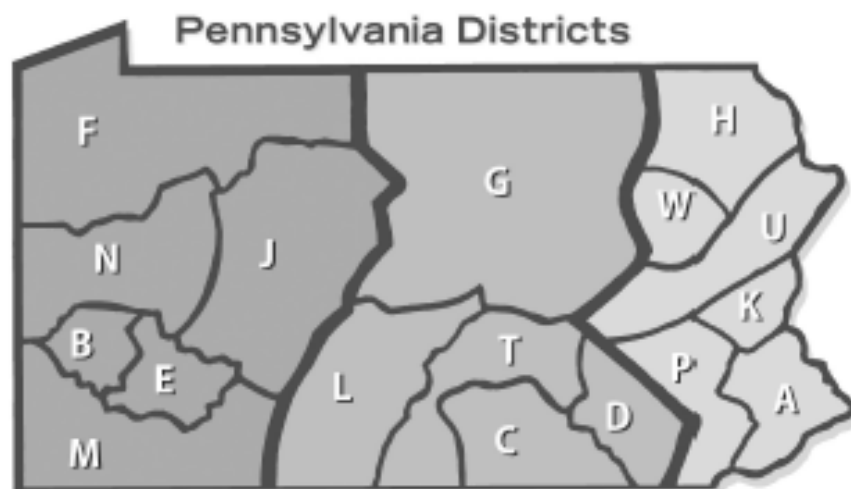

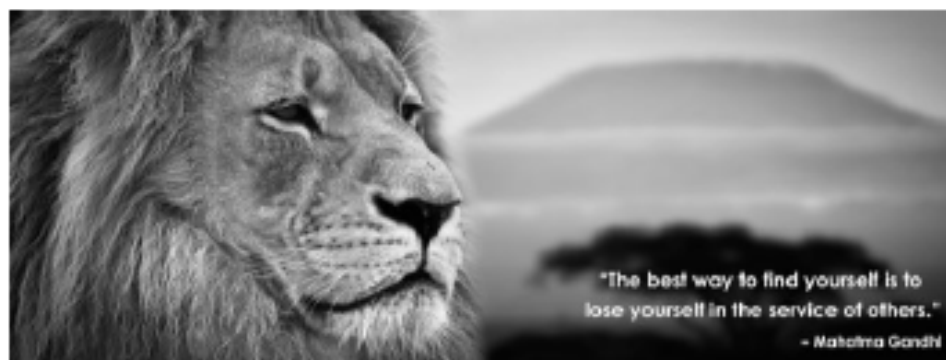
