GENERAL

The incoming District Governor shall appoint the Diabetes Chairperson.

DUTIES

The duties of the Diabetes Chairperson are as follows:

- 1. Obtains and makes available educational information through LCI and other appropriate organizations. Become familiar with the resources available on the LCI Website and LCI's initiatives related to diabetes awareness and prevention.
- 2. Speaks on diabetes to the District 14-C Lions and Lioness clubs and other organizations when invited.
- 3. Answers questions pertaining to diabetes including symptoms and treatment of diabetes.
- 4. Makes the general public aware of diabetes and the role that Lions play in diabetes education.
- 5. Works with clubs to identify and reach out to needy individuals suffering from diabetes in an attempt to improve their quality of life.
- 6. Assists the District Governor in diabetes fund-raisers.
- 7. Seeks new information by attending training and research seminars as offered locally and at state conventions or state council meetings.
