Access to MyLion

If you are one of these club officers, and you will be holding that office for the 2019-2020 year, and you have not yet registered for the MyLion application, please do so as soon as possible! MyLCI and MyLion are now both accessed by having a MyLion username and password. To register in MyLion, go to www.mylion.org, then click on the Sign Up Now link at the upper right on the Menu Bar. You will need you member number, then just enter the information and follow the prompts. Your username can be either your mobile phone number or your email address, then you create your own password.

Once you have accessed the MyLion site and created a user name and password, you then access MyLCI from the LCI website (www.lionsclubs.org). Once the website is accessed, you see a link at the top of the screen, which reads "MyLCI/MyLion LOGIN." When you click on that link, it will bring you to a screen that asks for you Username and Password. Remember that your username is either your mobile phone number or your email address, whichever you used to register.

Use will use MyLCI just like you did before. MyLCI is where club secretaries will record the 2019-2020 club officers as well as membership and service activities. *It is extremely important to register in MyLion since that is how you now access MyLCI.*
