JANUARY 28, 2017

<u>OPENING:</u> District Governor Cathy Valenzuela called the meeting to order at 10:04 am, and District Cabinet Treasurer Steve Shirley gave the invocation. 2nd Vice District Governor Sharon Agun led the Pledge of Allegiance. DG Cathy welcomed all Lions in attendance to the third District Cabinet Meeting of the Lions year. She thanked the Colorado Springs Downtown Lions Club for hosting the meeting and providing the lunch.

INTRODUCTIONS: DG Cathy introduced all the Past Council Chairmen present as well as all the Past District Governors present. She thanked all the Lions that brought canned goods to the meeting for distribution to the Care and Share Program and reported that contrary to the agenda, there would be no presentation by representatives from the Care and Share Program. She encouraged all Lions to sign the 100 Centennial Banner if they have not already done so, noting that it will be presented at the International Convention in Chicago. She explained the significance of all the handouts on tables that included a post card detailing information and the location for the final District Cabinet Meeting on April 22, 2017.

APPOINTMENT OF 1st VICE DISTRICT GOVERNOR: DG Cathy explained that there is a vacancy again for the position of 1st Vice District Governor; that previously appointed Lion Nancy Lodge has resigned; and that PDG Rick Calhoun has volunteered to fill the vacancy. DG Cathy reported that Lion Rick would need to be appointed by a vote of the District Cabinet Members during a portion of the meeting specifically called for this purpose; and that it would be just the District Cabinet Members who would vote on this appointment and not the other Cabinet Meeting attendees. Therefore, she called to order a special meeting within the larger cabinet meeting for the purpose of appointing a Lion to fill the current vacancy for 1st VDG. She asked for a motion from the District Cabinet Members to appoint PDG Rick Calhoun into the position of 1st VDG. It was moved by Lion PDG Monty Whitney, GMT Chairman, that Lion PDG Rick Calhoun be appointed to fill the vacancy for 1st VDG. Zone C Chairperson, Lion Betsy Denny seconded the motion. The motion received unanimous approval. DG Cathy thanked Lion Rick for volunteering and noted that he is currently at a regional VDG training.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

Club Roll Call – 36 District 6-SE Lions were present representing 12 clubs.

<u>Minutes of the last Cabinet Meeting</u> – Moved and seconded to accept the minutes from the cabinet meeting of 11/5/16 as submitted. Motion passed without objection. Minutes from the last cabinet meeting are on file, and copies of them were made available to interested Lions.

<u>Treasurer's Report –</u> District Cabinet Treasurer Steve Shirley presented his written report for the period July 2016 through December 2016, along with a profit and loss statement for the period. He noted that July semiannual dues to the state have been paid; that all clubs have paid their semiannual dues for July; and that fifteen clubs have paid their January semiannual dues so far. It was moved and seconded to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented. Motion passed without objection. The written report is on file.

<u>Cabinet Meeting Raffle:</u> DG Cathy reported that the District is still conducting a 50/50 raffle during Cabinet Meetings for \$10.00 per chance with the raffle proceeds to benefit the District Convention Fund by \$500.00. She encouraged Lions to buy two raffle chances, one for them and one for a program of their choice. She noted that she would like to have all the raffle chances sold by the end of the meeting. She reported that Lion Corry Higbee would be selling the raffle chances and encouraged all meeting attendees to participate.

<u>District Governor's Report</u> – DG Cathy highlighted her written report. She reported that she has visited all but 3 clubs; that she has delivered member chevrons during her visitations; that she has inducted many new members; that clubs should use the centennial new member packets when inducting new members; and that clubs should consider service activities that satisfy LCI's Legacy projects. She reported that after deliberation with district leaders, she believes the district should consider an increase in district dues, which if adopted by delegates to the district convention, would take effect in July 2017. She noted that the increase is necessary to meet continuing financial needs of district leadership. She further noted that in order to have this measure on the ballot at the district convention, a resolution to that effect would need to be passed by the by action at this District Cabinet Meeting. She asked that meeting attendees consider this resolution under unfinished business toward the end of the meeting. She also noted that her DG Bell has been returned to her after being stolen at the last District Cabinet Meeting. The written report is on file.

<u>2nd Vice District Governor Report</u> – 2nd VDG Sharon Agun presented a verbal report that highlighted the number of club visitations that she has made so far. She noted that she intends to recruit her cabinet members from the membership of smaller clubs. She reported on the prospect of a Lions Day at the Colorado Springs Sky Sox baseball game over the Labor Day weekend in September; that the event would be an activity for fellowship among district lions other than a business meeting; that it would occur during a weekend that features fireworks at the ball park, and that the Lions in attendance would be recognized at the game. She asked permission from the District Cabinet to pursue this activity. It was moved and seconded that 2nd VDG Sharon should pursue the Lions Day at the Sky Sox to be held on Friday evening 9/1/17, and to report her findings at the next District Cabinet Meeting. 2nd VDG Sharon submitted a written report providing some of the details of the event.

<u>GMT Report</u> – PDG Monty Whitney presented his written report. He noted that activity toward the creation of a club in Briargate has begun with the El Paso County/Tri Lakes Lions Club being the sponsor club. He explained that a zip code directory for the area would be used as a recruitment tool. His written report is on file.

Zone C – Lion Betsy Denny highlighted her written report which is on file.

<u>CLUB BRAG TIME</u>: Nine clubs paid for the honor of highlighting recent activities of their club. Three of the nine clubs used this brag time to also brag about the new Director of the Colorado Lions Camp and all the positive changes she is bringing to the camp.

BREAK IN THE PROCEEDINGS

COMMITTEE AND PROGRAM REPORTS:

2017 DISTRICT CONVENTION – DG Cathy reported that the date for the 2017 District Convention is May 19, 2017 at the Greenwood Village Double Tree Hotel in Denver. She reported that the convention is part of the MD-6 Convention at the same location on May 19-20, 2017; that there will be a contest between districts for the collection and display of canned food products; that a Fort Carson Color Guard will be featured; that each club will be encouraged to bring a display of some of their service projects; and that reports made at the convention will be asked to be made in an interactive format. She encouraged all Lions to attend the convention. She also gave some preliminary information on the 2018 MD-6 Convention to be held in Breckenridge.

SPEECH CONTEST – Coordinator Dennis Blevins presented his written report that specified the theme for the contest this year along with the rules for participation. He specified that inasmuch as the District Convention is part of the MD-6 Convention, that the District Contest will take place at the District Cabinet Meeting in Pueblo on April 22, 2017. He encouraged more clubs to participate and he displayed a Speech Contest Flyer developed by the Pueblo Charter Lions Club. The written report is on file.

LCIF – Coordinator PCC Bob Selle provided his written report highlighting the need for more Lions Clubs to support the Lions Measles Initiative. The written report is on file.

RMLEB – Lion Joanne Cook provided a written report highlighting the intent of the Eye Bank to again sponsor The Circle of Light Photo Project; that the Eye Bank continues to be a premier Eye Bank in the USA, and that the Eye Bank continues to accept applications for the Eye Surgery Fund. The written report is on file.

RMLEIF – Lion Jeanette Trimmer provided a written report highlighting the completion of 10 exams rooms at the Anschutz Medical Campus and that an article about their work will soon appear in the *Lion Magazine*. The written report is on file.

COLORADO LIONS FOUNDATION – President Lion Bryan Cooper provided a written report highlighting the current changes in filing being required by the IRS and that the foundation needs to determine how to fund the State Scholarship program. The written report is on file.

KIDSIGHT – Lion Fred Trimmer provide a written report highlighting the number of screenings and referral rate statewide, and the need for clubs in the state to be more generous with donations to the program. The written report is on file.

CENTENNIAL REPORT – PCC Sandy Smith encouraged all clubs to report their centennial service activities to LCI, especially those that satisfy the Legacy projects.

DISTRICT AWARDS LUNCHEON REPORT – DG Cathy reported that the District Cabinet Meeting on April 22, 2017 will feature the presentation of gifts and awards inasmuch as there will be little time for this at the District 6-SE portion of the State Convention on May 19, 2017.

OTHER BUSINESS/UNFINISHED BUSINESS/QUESTIONS: DG Cathy resumed discussion about the proposal to increase district dues for 2017-2018, and to have this proposal on the ballot at the District Convention on May 19, 2017. There followed a lengthy discussion about whether or not to seek an increase in dues, and if so, how much of an increase. The discussion concluded with a motion by Lion Fred Trimmer that a proposal to increase district dues from the current \$7.00 annually to \$10.00 annually, to be effective July 2017, be placed on the ballot at the District Convention on May 19, 2017. The motion was seconded by PCC Dr. Ron Smith and carried with a voice vote.

DG Cathy announced that all of the 50/50 raffles chances have been sold and the goal of raising \$500 for the District Convention Fund has been met. Therefore, the raffle drawing was held with the Flagler Lions Club being the winner.

There was no other business to come before the Cabinet.

<u>ADJOURN</u>; There being no further business to come before the Cabinet, DG Cathy adjourned the District Cabinet Meeting at 12:30 pm and lunch was served. Attendees were invited to remain after lunch for breakout sessions on how to obtain information from the LCI website.
