Guidelines for PDG Arthur Girio Scholarship Fund



- 1. Scholarship applicant inclusion criteria:
 - A member of a participating Lions Club, in good standing*
 - The child/grandchild (natural or adopted) of a Lions member in good standing* (living or deceased)
 - A student, who for 2 years, was a member of a Leo Club, in good standing
- 2. Scholarship applicant exclusion criteria:
 - A student who has previously received this award is not eligible to reapply
- 3. The applicant must submit written proof that he/she has enrolled for their 2nd year onward in a full-time undergraduate or graduate degree program at an accredited, recognized facility for post-secondary or graduate education of the student's choice
- 4. The applicant must submit written proof that he/she has maintained a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 in the immediate prior full year of full-time attendance at their place of post-secondary or graduate education
- 5. The applicant must submit a short written essay describing how the award would help them fulfill their educational goals. Please submit on a separate sheet of paper (maximum 50 words)
- 6. Application submission:
 - Applications must be submitted by a participating Lion Club in good standing* OR
 - Applications from past Leo members in good standing (member for a minimum of 2 years) can be submitted without sponsorship from a Lion, but must be accompanied by a recommendation from the student's former Leo Club Advisor
 - Applications are accepted annually between January 1st and March 15th
- 7. Upon approval of the scholarship, the successful applicant must submit a copy of a paid tuition receipt for the upcoming Fall semester
