Lion Lloyd has served several terms on the Univ. of Maine at Fort Kent Alumni Association Board of Directors, serving as the Alumni Board President for 12 of those years, being termed out this year, is currently the Vice President of the Elderly Social Council (Senior Club) of Fort Kent, is currently the Chair of the town's Budget Committee and a Eucharistic minister at St. Louis Catholic Church.
