Official Contest Rules

1. Contest Description and Conditions

The Lions World Lunch Relay Contest gives clubs the opportunity to enter their club in the contest in up to three categories, including the most friends and family, the best theme and the biggest food drive. Clubs may enter in more than one category; however a club may not win in more than one category.

2. Eligibility

In order to participate, clubs must meet the following criteria:

- Entrants must be a chartered Lions club, Campus Lions club, Lions club branch or Leo Lions club.
- Clubs must be in good standing.
- Clubs must be hosting a Lions World Lunch Relay event
- Clubs must pre-register Lions World Lunch Relay event at: www.lionsclubs.org/lunchrelayregistration

3. Contest Categories and Requirements

- a) Most Family and Friends. The most family and friends category will be judged based on the number of non-Lion attendees who attend the club's Lions World Lunch Relay event. The lunch with the most non-Lion attendees will win. Category required documentation includes: 1) Completed entry form. 2) A group photo showing non-Lion attendees. 3) A numbered list of all non-Lion attendees.
- b) Best Theme. The best theme category will be judged, by the International President, on the creativity and incorporation of the theme into the lunch. The club with the most creative theme, and best incorporation of that theme will win. Category required documentation includes: 1) Completed entry. 2) A photo that represents the theme of the lunch.
- c) Biggest Food Drive. The biggest food drive category will be judged based on the number of food items the club collected. The club who collects the most food items will win. Category required documentation includes: 1) Completed entry form. 2) A photo displaying the entire collection of food items (food items must be visible). 3) The name of the organization or group that received your club's food donation. Examples of food items include: one can of green beans, one box of spaghetti, one box of granola bars or one case of bottled water. Items should not be separated from their original package or box.

4. Photo Submissions

Clubs may submit no more than five photos of their Lions World Lunch Relay event, including the required photos for each category, to support their contest entry. Submitted photos should be at least 1MB in size, and must be .JPG, .TIFF or .PNG format. All photos submitted become the property of Lions Clubs International. To obtain permission to publish photos taken by your club, download the [Photo/Video Authorization Form](#) and/or [Child Photo/Video Authorization Form](#).

5. Contest Period

The contest will run from April 1, 2014 through April 30, 2014. All Lions World Lunch Relay events entered into the contest must be held during this time period. Contest entry forms will be accepted through April 30, 2014.

6. How to Enter

- Register a Lions World Lunch Relay event at www.lionsclubs.org/lunchrelayregistration.
- Host a Lions World Lunch Relay event in the month of April, 2014.
- Complete the *Lions World Lunch Relay Contest Entry Form*. All required information on the contest entry form must be complete.
- Submit the *Lions World Lunch Relay Contest Entry Form*, via email, by April 30, 2014 to _____@lionsclubs.org. Paper entries will not be accepted.
 - All required documentation (including the entry form, up to 5 photos and non-Lion attendee list) must be included in the email submission.

7. Judging

Contest Judging will begin on May 1, 2014 and end by May 31, 2014. All contest entries will be judged by LCI staff and/or the International President.

8. Notification and Recognition of Winners

Winners will be notified by May 31, 2014 via the email address provided on the entry form. Winning clubs will be recognized on the LCI Website, at the 2013 International Convention and mentioned on LCI social media pages.

9. Prizes

Winning clubs will receive a Lions World Lunch Relay banner patch.
