District 14B - Policy No. 100

Policy on Territorial Restrictions on the Clubs in Fundraising

PURPOSE: To define the territories in which the Clubs may conduct fund-raising and provide a procedure for settling disputes between Clubs

GENERAL: The city, township or borough boundaries will be used as the restrictions for door-to-door sales or for telephone solicitations or sales by adjacent Lions Clubs unless other divisions are previously agreed upon, except that the territories to be covered by Clubs within the City of Pittsburgh will be determined by a conference between the District Governor and representatives of each such Clubs.

In the event that any Club is contemplating using a professional fund-raising firm or individual, it is mandatory that the District Governor be consulted before any contract is signed. There are **no exceptions** to this rule.

Any dispute on boundaries will be settled by a committee consisting of three (3) Past District Governors appointed by the District Governor. The Past District Governors will be selected from diverse areas of the District. Sales by Lions at their place of business will be exempt from any and all restrictions.

Any Lions, Lioness or Leo Club engaging in solicitation outside said Clubs' territory will be recommended for **STATUS QUO** immediately when the District Governor has been officially notified, **IN WRITING**, and he (District Governor) verifies the solicitation to be fact.
