Policy on Territorial Restrictions on the Clubs on Membership

PURPOSE: To assist the clubs in knowing where they may seek members.

GENERAL: Traditionally, a Lions Club is restricted to the confines of a certain municipality for members, and those who live within or have business interests within that area are eligible for membership. However, now that new members are getting harder and harder to obtain, and most new members being those who know somebody in the club, a new member may be admitted, regardless of where they live or where they work. There is no territorial restriction whatever on membership in any Lions Club.
