District 14B - Policy No. 110

Policy on Procedure to Select Recipient of Donated Eye Prosthesis

PURPOSE: To define the method for selecting the recipient of the eye prosthesis which is donated annually by Walter T. Tillman, III, B.C.O., F.A.S.O.

GENERAL: In accordance with the agreement effective May 17, 1999, Walter T. Tillman, III will provide three (3) eye prostheses annually to three (3) needy persons, selected from the six (6) Western Districts of Multiple District 14 (B,E,F,J,M and N) [copy of agreement attached]

The candidates will be selected on a first come-first serve basis.

The District Governor of District 14-B will be the administrator of the program.

The selection process of District 14-B will be as follows:

- A.** Any request for assistance in the procurement of an eye prosthesis received by a Lion, Lioness or Leo in the District will be forwarded to the Coordinator of Blind Activities and/or the District Governor.
- B.** The Coordinator of Blind Activities will determine the extent of support required by the individual or the sponsoring Club and report the findings to the District Governor.
- C.** The District Governor and his Cabinet will determine, in regular or special session, whether the individual will receive the donated prosthesis.
- D.** The District Governor will notify Walter T. Tillman, III, of the selection of the individual who is to receive the prosthesis.

In the event the selected individual requires more than the normal fitting, fabrication and adjustments, Walter T. Tillman, III, will notify

the District Coordinator and recommend a course of action to care for the individual's needs.

AGREEMENT

LIONS CLUBS OF DISTRICTS B, E, F, J, M AND N OF WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA

AND

WALTER T. TILLMAN, III, F.A.S.O.

THE LIONS CLUBS OF THE SIX (6) WESTERN DISTRICTS OF MULTIPLE DISTRICT 14 (PENNSYLVANIA) GRACIOUSLY ACCEPT THE GENEROUS OFFER OF WALTER T. TILLMAN, III, F.A.S.O., TO PROVIDE THREE (3) ARTIFICIAL EYES, FREE OF CHARGE, TO THREE (3) NEEDY PERSONS EACH LION YEAR (JULY-JUNE). HIS SERVICES WILL INCLUDE: FITTING, FABRICATION AND FOLLOW-UP EXAMINATION AND ADJUSTMENTS OF THE EYE PROSTHESIS.

THE RECIPIENT OF WALTER T. TILLMAN'S, III, SERVICES WILL BE SELECTED FROM ANY OF THE SIX (6) WESTERN DISTRICTS ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS ANNUALLY. THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR AND/OR DISTRICT COORDINATOR OF EYE PROSTHESIS OF 14-B WILL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE PROGRAM.

WALTER T. TILLMAN, III, RESERVES THE RIGHT TO WITHDRAW THIS AGREEMENT AT ANY TIME WITH NOTIFICATION TO THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR OF DISTRICT 14-B.
