District 14B - Policy No. 301

**Policy to Define the Duties of District
Blind Bowlers Tournament Chairperson**

PURPOSE: To outline the duties and responsibilities of District 14-B for the annual Keystone Blind Bowlers Tournament.

GENERAL: The general duties are outlined in the District Chairperson's policy. The specific duties are as follows but not limited to:

1. Work closely with the Keystone Blind Bowlers Association which sponsors the bowling tournament.
2. Contact all the Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs in the district by mail or e-mail through the district newsletter and ask for their participation in the tournament.
 - a. The tournament is conducted on Friday, Saturday and Sunday at the time selected by the Keystone Blind Bowlers group.
 - b. The Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs of each region is asked to provide manpower for the tournament throughout the weekend. The day each region is to provide help is selected by a random drawing conducted at the cabinet meeting. The district cabinet officers are to participate all three days.
3. Solicit the clubs for funds to offset the district contribution to the tournament.
 - a. The District's will contribute \$15.00 per bowler not to exceed \$1,500.00 in any year to the tournament to offset the expenses for the tournament.
 - b. The district account should not be in excess of \$1,500.00 annually. These funds shall be considered start-up money for the

following year. Any excess funds over the \$1,500.00 to be transferred to the District's Blind Contingency Fund.

- c. The chairperson may request an annual contribution from the Lions Clubs of up to \$50.00 or less depending on the balance in the account.
