**Policy to Define the Duties of  
Lions Clubs International Foundation Chairperson**

**PURPOSE:** To establish guidelines to help with the promotion and execution of L.C.I.F. projects and its International humanitarian purposes.

**GENERAL:** The Lions Clubs International Foundation Chairperson will work to encourage contributions and promote the International Foundation. The specific responsibilities shall be to:

1. Promote the LCIF objectives such as:
  - A. Provide a vehicle through which Lions of every nation can help other Lions to help people.
  - B. Monies donated to LCIF are channeled to well planned, well controlled projects, which are essentially Lionistic in character.
2. Study the information in the District LCIF Chairman Guide and be knowledgeable of its contents.
3. Be aware of the established District Governor's club goals for the District.
4. Be prepared to present programs to clubs within the District to educate them about LCIF, its operation and the benefits it provides.
5. Report to the District Cabinet the LCIF activities within the District.
6. Know that monies contributed in the District as non-designated funds may be designated for a specific purpose by the District Governor and his Cabinet and as chairman, be aware of the District Governor's choice.
7. Familiarize the clubs with the Melvin Jones Fellowship.
