District 14-B - Policy No. 316

Policy to Define the Duties of the Membership Chairperson

PURPOSE: To set forth the general responsibilities of the District Governor's appointed chairman for Membership in the District. The appointment of the Membership Chairman is a three (3) year appointment beginning in July 1988 and will be made every three (3) years thereafter.

GENERAL:

1. The District Membership Chairperson shall:
 - A. Be responsible for the membership growth in the District.
 - B. Be committed to serve in the position for a minimum of three years.
 - C. Attend education sessions on ways to perform his/her duties and responsibilities.
 - D. Assist in conducting training sessions for the Zone membership and club membership chairpersons.
 - E. Act as the Chairman of a committee comprised of Zone Membership Chairman.
 - F. Establish goals for net gain, plan strategies to meet these goals.
 - G. Maintain a list of all District Lions Clubs membership committees.
2. Submit written membership reports at the Cabinet meetings and outline programs and meetings that will be occurring throughout the year.
